	The Race		The Convoy Cup Regatta will be comprised of two events the Ocean Race (Convoy Cup) and the Bassin Race (Veterans' Cup). The overnight ocean race of 100 nautical miles (the "Convoy Cup Ocean Race"). Course and distance may be adjusted according to forecast winds and conditions, at the sole discretion of the Dartmouth Yacht Club ("DYC") Race Committee. The race will commence on September 7, 2024, at a line established between the transom of the HMCS Sackville and a set mark. The race shall finish in Halifax Harbour in the vicinity of West Outer Middle Ground light buoy

15. Risk Statement and	In accordance with the RRS # 3 'The responsibility for a boat's decision
release of Liability	to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By
	participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges
