Tracking



Relies on cell signal

After a loss of coverage, will upload recorded data

Keep a phone plugged in and in GPS receptior

One phone per boat

Separate viewing app

DO NOT use for navigation or race course





Track your sailing with KWINDOO Tracking, or join organized regatta events worldwide. Use Self tracking for your sailing. Track your sailed route, take photos or videos on your boat directly form the app during the sailing and save them together with your tracking. Share your tracking with friends, so they can follow your sailing live.

Join Sailing regatta and see the racecourse on your smartphone. Check your bearing and distance






- QHM OPS VHF Channel 10, at Scroggs Rocks

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Sequence of Events on Saturday



Section 5 - Schedule of Events for Saturday, October 23 is amended to read as follows (Changes Highlighted)

Saturday, October 23

0845 ~ CFSA Clubhouse operations centre will be open and race packages will begin to be delivered to boats checking in to the harbour. Check-ins will be prioritised by race start and participants are encouraged to arrive as early as possible to facilitate check-in

0950 ~ Boats can no longer change their race selection

0950 ~ Check in complete -

1000 ~ Short and Cruiser Class courses announced

1030 ~ Long Distance & US Shadow Race Start

1040 ~ Medium Race Start

1050 ~ Short Course Race Start

1100 ~ Cruiser Class Start

1900 ~ Time Limit for the Short course and Cruiser Class


*** If a race doesn't start the subsequent race start will move forward in the schedule with minimal delay


