## 1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the class rules of I420 and 505 One Design Classes
- 1.3 The Santa Cruz Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.

# 2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all boats of the International 420 class and the 505 One Design class.
- 2.2 Sailors competing in the I420 class must be current members of the US I420 Class Association www.usi420.org/ or for non-US residents, of their own National Governing Body.

## **3 REGISTRATION AND FEES**

3.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form online at

https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/3zQOORatK0/class prior to 9.00am November 13, 2021.

3.2. Entry fee is \$100.00 per boat.

# 4 Schedules

- 4.1 Thursday (Nov 11) 1900 Competitors' Meeting by Zoom Link to be emailed to registered competitors on this day prior by 1800.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1155 hours each race day.
- 4.3 No races will be started after 1545 hours Sunday November 14, 2021.
- 4.4 Seven (7) races are scheduled for the regatta.

# **5 Sailing Instructions**

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and online at https://theclubspot.com/regatta/3zQOORatK0

#### 6 Venue

6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

# 7 Courses

7.1 A course diagram will be provided in the sailing instructions.

# 8 Scoring

- 8.1. The Low-Point Scoring system, RRS Appendix A, will apply.
- 8.2. Three (3) races will constitute a regatta.
- 8.3. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all of her race scores. When five (5) or more races have been completed, a competitor's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

### 9. SAFETY

9.1. Competitors must wear while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing, a properly secured personal floatation device. For I420 class it must conform to I420 class rule C.3.1. Wetsuits and drysuits do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy.

#### 10 Prizes

10.1. Prizes will be awarded to skipper and crew for the top 3 places.
