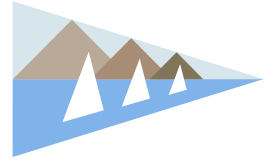




NOTICE OF RACE



Rocky Mountain Snipe Championship and World Qualifier September 17, 18 and 19, 2021

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

Snipe Fleet #210 and Union Sailing Club in co-operation with SCIRA USA

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) available at http://www.snipe.org/images/2018Rules/SCIRA_2018_Rules-of-Conduct-final.pdf.
- 1.3 National prescriptions of US Sailing will apply.
- 1.4 RRS Appendix T will apply.
- 1.5 The top US boat* will be eligible to qualify for the 2022 SCIRA World Championship.
*One additional slot will be awarded from the event with the highest number of boats: 1) the Don Q in Miami, Florida, 2) the Carolyn Nute Memorial Regatta in San Diego, California, and 3) the Rocky Mountain Snipe Championship.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be made available on the regatta website (<http://www.fleet210.org/rmsc/>) before the event and at the Competitor's meeting.

3. COMMUNICATION

From the first warning until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the race committee, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

4. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 Boats shall enter the Regatta by completing the on-line registration and paying the entry fee on the event website: <https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/6tRZPG15XB/class>
- 4.2 Full payment must be received for registration to be complete.
- 4.3 All skippers, crews, and boats are required to be properly registered with SCIRA as evidenced by a registration decal and/or online verification.

5. FEES

\$100.00 if received by 18:00 on September 3, 2021.
\$125.00 if received between 1800 hours on September 3, 2021 and 18:00 on September 16, 2021.
No entries will be allowed after 18:00 on September 16, 2021.

6. ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20.
- 6.2 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

7. RACING SCHEDULE

No more than eight (8) races are scheduled with one discard upon completion of six (6) races.

Friday, September 17

09:00 – Check-in

13:00 – Three (3) or more races back-to-back

Saturday, September 18

13:00 – Three (3) or more races back-to-back

Sunday, September 19

09:30 – Two (2) or more races back-to-back

8. VENUE

8.1 Union Sailing Club, County Road 26, Longmont, Colorado 80504.

8.2 Trailer launching is available at the public launch ramp at the Union Reservoir Park site. Union Sailing Club's launch ramp is dolly-launch only. Any boats being brought onsite must report to the Union Reservoir Park main gate to be inspected for Aquatic Nuisance Species (ANS) by the Park staff prior to launching. This applies to all boats, even those launched at the USC dolly-only ramp. Day Park Pass is REQUIRED \$12/day for vehicle and \$8/day for trailered boat. Park passes can be purchased at the Union Reservoir Park main gate.

9. COURSES

The courses to be sailed as per the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3 applies. The penalty is 2 (two) places.

11. SCORING

If six (6) or more races are scored, each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By Participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

13. PRIZES

Skipper and crew for first through seventh places.

14. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to SCIRA, the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recording, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
