



WILSON ICE ALCOHOL POLICY

To ensure compliance with Texas law, Wilson Ice has established the following alcohol policy for its members:

1. Membership and Alcohol Ownership

Collective Ownership: All alcoholic beverages on the premises are collectively owned by the members of Wilson Ice. The club purchases alcohol on behalf of its members, and individual members do not buy drinks directly. Instead, they reimburse the club for their share of the collectively owned alcohol.

2. Service of Alcohol

On-Premises Consumption: Alcoholic beverages are served for on-premises consumption only to members, their families, and guests.

Service Charges: Members may be charged for the service of alcoholic beverages, including setups (ice, mixers, etc.), but not for the beverages themselves.

3. Age Restrictions

Legal Drinking Age: Members and guests must be at least 21 years old to consume alcoholic beverages. Providing alcohol to minors is strictly prohibited and is an offense under Texas law.

4. Guest Policy

Guest Consumption: Guests may consume alcoholic beverages on the premises only when accompanied by a member.

5. Compliance and Enforcement

Adherence to Laws: Wilson Ice operates in strict compliance with the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code and the regulations set forth by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC).

Policy Violations: Any member or guest found violating this policy or any applicable laws will be subject to disciplinary action, which may include suspension or termination of membership and potential legal consequences.

This policy is designed to promote responsible alcohol consumption and ensure that Wilson Ice remains in full compliance with Texas laws governing private clubs.
