1 Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the RACING RULES OF SAILING (RRS).
- 1.2 The “class rules” for the purposes of the definition of *rules* are the [International Laser Class Association \(ILCA\) Rules](#).
- 1.3 Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will not apply.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The event is open to boats of the ILCA 4, ILCA 6, ILCA 7 classes that meet ILCA Rules.
- 4.2 ILCA 4, ILCA 6 and ILCA 7 competitors who are members of [ILCA-NA](#), or their National Laser Class Association, may enter by completing the registration and paying the required fees. Competitors with memberships outside of ILCA-NA must contact office@ilcanasailing.org with proof of membership before registering.
- 4.3 Competitors and coaches shall complete the Liability Release and Medical Consent forms as part of the event registration.

5 Registration

- 5.1 Competitors and Coaches shall register online here:
<https://ephraimyachtclub.theclubspot.com/register/regatta/FzFnmpa7rF/class> before 7-17-26.
Registrations not fully paid by this time may be rejected.
- 5.2 The entry fee for each competitor is \$100. Competitors who have not paid the Entry Fee by midnight 7-4-26 will be charged a \$25 late fee. Competitors who register late are not guaranteed the planned regatta meals, giveaways, etc.
- 5.3 There is no entry fee for a Coach but are required to register at Ephraim Yacht Club. A Coach Flag shall be prominently displayed on any coach boat.
- 5.4 Spectator boats are required to register at Ephraim Yacht Club (no fee).

6 Event Format

- 6.1 If a fleet has a large number of entries, the Organizing Authority may divide that fleet.

7 Schedule of Events

- 7.1 7-16-26 Competitors permitted to arrive at Ephraim Yacht Club
7-17-26 Race Clinic by Tarkan Bolat 9am-4pm(No limit). On water regatta coaching available.(Limit 4)

7.2 No more than four races per fleet will be scheduled for each day, except if fewer than three races have been completed on a prior race day, then a fourth race may be attempted.

7.3 A minimum of three (3) races shall constitute a regatta. A maximum of seven (7) races, in total, are scheduled for the entire regatta.

8 Measurement

8.1 All boats and equipment must meet ILCA Rules and may be inspected by the RC, Protest Committee, or Technical Committee for compliance with the Rules at any time during the event.

8.2 Sail inspection will be required at this regatta. Each boat shall comply with the equipment measurement rules of the ILCA Rules and may be inspected at any time during the Regatta at the discretion of the Protest Committee or the Organizing Authority.

8.3 Please ensure that all sail numbers are applied in accordance with ILCA Rules. National letters are not required, however, if used, national letters must comply with ILCA Rules.

8.4 All hulls must display a certifying class decal in the aft-end of the cockpit [see ILCA Rules, part 2, Section 4(a)]. The RC issues blanket permission per ILCA Rules, Part 2. Section 4(e)ii: competitors may use a sail with numbers that are different to the sail number allocated to the hull.

9 Sailing Instructions

9.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on or before check-in.

10 Venue

10.1 The racing area will be located at Eagle Harbor in the vicinity of Ephraim Yacht Club.

11 Courses

11.1 Courses will be Windward/Leeward.

12 Scoring

12.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used, except as modified below. 12.2 When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 Support Boats

13.1 Support/coach/spectator boats shall register with the Race Office during the regatta check in period.

13.2 A unique registration number will be assigned to each support boat. Support, coach and spectator boats shall prominently display their assigned number at all times while on the water.

13.3 Coaches are support boats and are required to monitor the RC channel on their VHF radios and be available to assist with safety when requested. Coaches are expected to attend the skippers meeting each morning.

13.4 Rules governing the conduct of support/coach/spectator boats will be in the Sailing Instructions.

14 Administrative

14.1 Competitors are welcome to arrive at Ephraim Yacht Club on 7-16-26

14.2 Unfortunately, parking at Ephraim Yacht Club is extremely limited. Boats can be stored on dollies on our dock but trailers and cars must be parked on the street or at some of the other public parking lots just south and north of the club. Ephraim Yacht Harbor just to our south is not affiliated with EYC. Its private parking places are not available to EYC members or guests. Please do not park in or block EYH spaces. Except when dropping or picking up boats it is forbidden to drive down the shared driveway.

15 Disclaimer of Liability

15.1 Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, the sponsors, the race committee, officers and board of directors of Ephraim Yacht Club, and all those involved in these organizations will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after this regatta.

15.2 All competitors must turn in a signed waiver before racing. Competitors under 18 years of age must have the waiver signed by a parent or guardian.

16 Prizes

16.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top positions with 1 prize for every 8 boats registered, with a minimum of 3 registrants and a maximum of 5 prizes positions in each Class.

16.2 1 prize in the ILCA 7 for a junior who shall not have had their 18th birthday before the first day of racing.
