1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Oceanside Yacht Club, that is the organizing authority, operates this regatta to benefit Elizabeth Hospice's mission: to provide comfort and counsel to children and adults who are facing life's most difficult challenges.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Changes to racing rule(s), if any, will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to RS Teras (rigged with a sport sized mainsail). All junior participants must wear a PFD.
- 2.2 Registration: Online registration is encouraged via www.oceansideyc.net prior to the skippers' meeting.
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: a completed Race Entry Card and Waiver, Attachment A, and required fee are submitted to the Race Committee prior to the conclusion of the skippers' meeting. The Race Committee may extend this deadline if applicable to all participants.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:

Oceanside Yacht Club member	\$25
Non-Oceanside Yacht Club member	\$35

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Date of racing: July 25th, 2026
- 4.2 Number of races: Five races are planned for each class and fleet.
- 4.3 A skippers' meeting is scheduled for 10:30 on day of the race downstairs at OYC.

- 4.4 The scheduled time of the class flag (warning signal) for the first race is 11:57. The warning signal will be made three minutes before the starting signal. This changes RRS 26, Starting Races.

- 4.5 No warning signal will be made after 15:30.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Published sailing instructions include any supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at Oceanside Yacht Club office.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 Attachment A shows the location of parking and Oceanside Yacht Club.

- 6.2 Launching and parking:

Boats can be launched from public ramps in the South Harbor. Trailer parking near these ramps requires a nominal fee. Sail to the end of I-Dock by OYC in North Harbor.

Alternatively, boats can be side-carried through a 4'-0" wide gate by the yacht club located in the North Harbor. Side dollies will be available. Trailer parking is permitted on North Harbor Drive near the yacht club.

- 6.3 Attachment B shows the protected outer harbor race area.

7 COURSE DIAGRAM

Attachment C shows the course, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The race committee reserves the right to use additional courses not included in Attachment C. Course lengths will be set so that each race is about 25-35 minutes long.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

For all classes, RRS 44.1, Taking a Penalty, is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9 SCORING

9.1 The scoring system follows RRS Appendix A, Scoring.

9.2 Two completed races are required to constitute a series.

9.3 There will be no race discards.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: At least three trophies will be awarded. Four trophies will be awarded if more than eight boats participate .

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

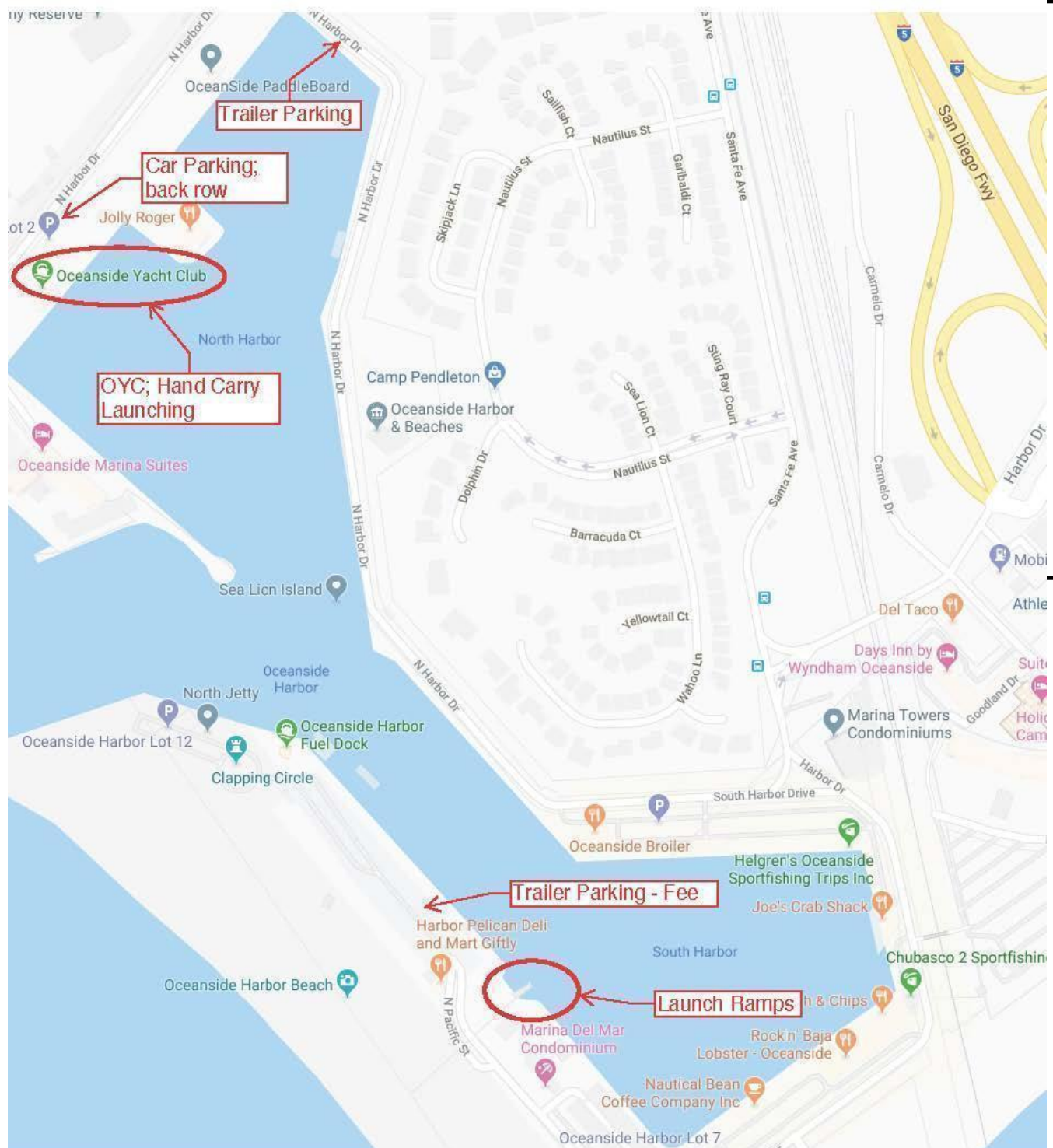
