# Notice of Race

## 1 CLASSES

The regatta is open to all members of the Lido 14 Class Association who propose to sail duly measured boats.

## 2 ENTRIES

2.1 Entry must be completed prior to 10:00 am, October 3, 2026, through the MBYC signup website at <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/pYnyHzasBn>

2.2 Any eligible boat may register as Lido A or Lido B. Registrants may switch between A and B until the close of registration. Participants are encouraged to make a fair assessment of their abilities, the condition of their boat and skipper and crew experience.

2.3 The entry fee for the regatta is **\$40.00**.

## 3 SCHEDULE

3.1 A competitor's meeting will be held on Saturday at 10:00 am at the flagpole at MBYC.

3.2 The first warning will be at noon both days for Lido As, followed by Lidos Bs. The start of the second race will be as soon as possible after the completion of the first race and so forth.

3.3 Target number of races is four (4) on Saturday and three (3) on Sunday. A minimum of two races shall constitute a regatta.

## 4 RULES

4.1 The organizing authority for this regatta is Mission Bay Yacht Club.

4.2 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing as amended and adopted by US Sailing, except as amended by the MBYC Sailing Instructions.

4.3 Changes in the Sailing Instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The official notice board is on the south side of the MBYC clubhouse.

4.4 The minimum crew weight requirement, as recognized by the National Lido Class Association of 300 pounds, will be in place.

## 5 COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The racing will be in Sail Bay, just East of the Mission Bay Yacht Club clubhouse.

5.2 The courses for these races will be prescribed in the sailing instructions.

## **6 LAUNCHING**

6.1 There are two hoists at the MBYC back dock and are both available for launching.

6.2 Overnight trailer parking is provided at the club. Check in at the front desk at MBYC for any questions and trailer parking location.

## **7 RECOGNITION & SCORING**

7.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers of both Lido A and Lido B Fleets.

7.2 The winner of the A Fleet will receive the Robert Lesnick Memorial Trophy and the winner of the B Fleet will receive the Roger Patterson Memorial Trophy.

7.3 The perpetual trophies will be engraved at the expense of Lido Fleet 7 and will remain in the MBYC Trophy Case.

7.4 When fewer than seven races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores. When seven or more races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of all its race scores excluding her worst excludable score.

## **8 MEAL INFORMATION**

8.1 Breakfast and lunch are available at the MBYC galley for a reasonable cost.

8.2 Saturday after racing there will be a Chili Dinner in the Bodrero Building.

## **9 MBYC RULES AND RESTRICTIONS**

9.1 Motor homes or recreational vehicles are allowed inside the MBYC gate but no camping or overnight lodging is allowed within the club.

9.2 No pets are allowed on the MBYC grounds.

9.3 Smoking is not allowed in any of the club buildings, or on any club patios or beaches.

9.4 Empty boat trailers should be parked along the west fence.

9.5 Boats are welcome to arrive the previous week to set up for the regatta. Please check in at the front office and ask for a temporary tag for your trailer.
