



Kitsilano Yacht Club Janet Stamper Series 2022 Sailing Instructions

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024* (referred to in this document as RRS), the Prescriptions of Sail Canada, and the rules of the *Cal 20 Class Association*.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on The Official Notice Board, located north of the main entrance just inside the KYC Clubhouse.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any change in the *Sailing Instructions* will be posted on the Official Notice Board by 09:00 on the day it will take effect.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the KYC flagpole.

4.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, “1 minute” is replaced with “not less than 30 minutes” in the Race Signal AP.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 The 2022 Janet Stamper Spring Series shall take place on the following dates: Apr 10th, Apr 24th, May 15th, May 29th, Jun 12th

5.2 The 2022 Janet Stamper Fall Series shall take place on the following dates: Sep 4th, Sep 18th, Oct 2, Oct 16th, Oct 30th

5.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 11:00.

5.4 No warning signal shall be made after 14:30.

6. CLASS FLAGS

6.1 The Class Flag shall bear the insignia of the Cal20 Class.

7. MARKS

7.1 The starting marks will be an orange flag on the Race Committee Signal Boat at the starboard end and a staff displaying an orange flag at the port end.

7.2 Rounding marks 1 and 2 will be red/orange tetrahedrons, and are to be rounded to port.

7.3 The finishing marks will be a blue flag on the Race Committee Boat and a staff displaying a blue flag.

8. THE START

8.1 Races will be started by using RRS 26 with the warning signal made 5 minutes before the starting signal.

8.2 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the race committee signal boat at the starboard end and a staff displaying a red or orange flag at the port end.

9. CHANGE OF COURSE

9.1 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark to a new position.

10. THE FINISH

10.1 The finish line will be between a blue flag on the race committee signal boat and a staff displaying a blue flag.

11. TIME LIMITS

11.1 The Race Time Limit is 60 minutes.

11.2 The Mark 1 Time Limit is 30 minutes.

11.3 If no boat has passed Mark 1 within the time limit, the race shall be abandoned.

12. SCORING

12.1 The Fall 2022 JS Series Total points for each competitor will be combined with their Total points in the Spring 2022 JS Series to determine the ranking for the Janet Stamper Trophy.

12.2 A yacht that ranks as a competing yacht on fewer than 3 race days in a series will be considered a non-participant and will not be counted in the scoring. This changes *RRS Appendix A4 (Points System)* and *A9 (Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta)*.

12.3 The Janet Stamper Series will be scored according to *RRS Appendix A (Scoring)* using the *Low Point Scoring System*, with the following provisions for discarding worst scores:

Completed Races	Discards
1-3	0
4-6	1
7-10	2
11-15	3
16 or more	4

12.4 Scoring Abbreviations, as listed in *RRS Appendix A (Scoring)*, and Points Given for each:

Scoring Abbreviation	Points Given
DNC, DSQ, UFD, BFD, DNE	Registrants + 1
DNS, OCS	Starters + 1
DNF, RET	Finishers + 1

13. INSURANCE

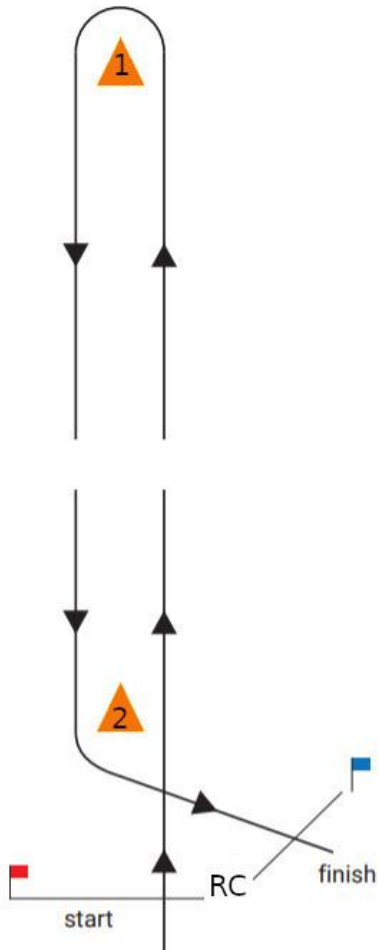
13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance

Numeral Pennant one (white flag with red circle) shall be displayed

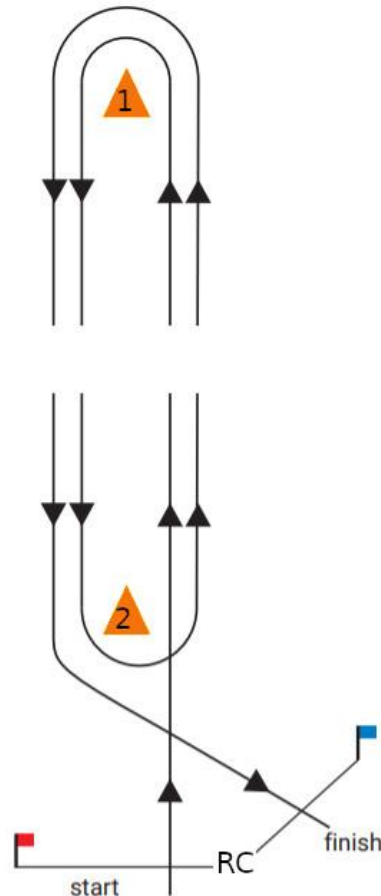


Start-1-2-Finish
