NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules: This Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing and the individual class rules, unless modified by the sailing instructions.

2. Eligibility:

2.1. International Optimist Dinghies (Red, Blue, White), Opti Green, Feva, 420, Laser Radial

2.2. For Optimists, determining date for each fleet is skipper's age on the day of the regatta

RedFleet: Age 13-15

BlueFleet: Age 11-12

WhiteFleet: Age 10 & under

GreenFleet: Beginner racers, up to 15

3. Entry Fee:

3.1. Fees:

Singlehand (Opti and Laser) - \$30

Double Handed (Feva/420) - \$60

3.2. Payment & Registration via The ClubSpot

3.3. Entry Fee Includes racing, give-away, trophies for top three finishers, and post-sailing snack .

3.4. Coaches/instructors/parents may purchase food with cash, credit card at the snackbar

12:30: First Gun for for Opti RBW, FEVA, 420, Laser Radial

12:45: First Gun for Opti Green Fleet

3:45: No race will start after 3:45

5. Scoring:

- 5.1. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will be used.
- 5.1. One Race Constitutes Series.
- 5.3. If 6 or more races are completed there will be one throwout.

6. Notice to Competitors: Notices To Competitors will be posted on the club noticeboard.

7. Prizes:

- 7.1. Prizes for RWB Optimist Class, Feva, Laser Radial & 420s will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each fleet.
- 7.2. Participation Medals will be given to all Optimist Green fleet sailors.

8. Safety Requirements:

- 8.1. All sailors shall wear a USCG approved PFD, secured properly at all times on the water.
- 8.2. All class required safety equipment is mandatory.
- 8.3. All coach/support boats must have a working VHF radio and be prepared to help any sailor in need.
- 8.4. All competitors, coaches, and parents must follow state, local, and Club guidelines to limit Covid transmission, including masks indoors and on club premises.

9. Responsibility for Safety: As a condition of the participation of any boat in any race or related activity sponsored or undertaken by the Sachems Head Yacht Club: the owner, helmsman and each crew member agree that the safety of the boat and the crew and the decision whether or not to start or continue to race is solely their responsibility, and each of them waives all claims which he or she, or any heir, representative, successor or assignee, may have against the Sachems Head Yacht Club, and any of their officers, trustees, members, committees, employees or agents, arising out of or in any way connected with participation in such race or activity. Responsibility for evaluating wind, sea, and weather conditions rests with each competitor, as does the responsibility for the safe condition and operation of their boat, including safety equipment and rigging and for wearing life jacket. Assistance from the race committee, patrol boats, or other support boats and from personnel manning them is at the risk of the participant.
