1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2025-2028

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Hampton Yacht Club General Sailing Instructions will apply, supplemental Sailing Instructions may be posted to the online event details page.

COMMUNICATION

3.1 The Official Notice Board is located online at the event details page.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEE

4.1 Eligible boats must be entered electronically through the event details page and received no later than 1600 on the day prior to the race. (Vessels registered with the HYC Big Boat Series by March 31 will be automatically entered into this event).

4.2 Eligible boats must provide proof of a valid rating certificate applicable to their class (PHRF, ORC, etc.)

4.3 Any fleet change must be done via e-mail waterfront@hamptonyc.com, prior to the entry deadline.

QUALIFYING SERIES

6.1 This event will count towards the HYC Cup and CCVR High Point Standings.



VENUE and COURSE

7.1 The sailing venue will be Hampton Flats in the vicinity of designated Mark “H” (Harbor) (R N “20”).

7.2 It is the intent of the RC to run three windward/leeward races each day per HYC Big Boat Series General S.I.s.

SCORING

8.1 Scoring for this series will be PHRF Windward/Leeward ratings. Time on Distance.

8.2 If a minimum of five (5) races are completed, a vessel’s overall series score will be her best of 5 races.

EQUIPMENT

9.1 All boats must meet US Sailing’s “Nearshore” Safety Equipment Requirements.

SCHEDULE and ORDER OF STARTS

10.1 RRS 26 as modified by HYC Big Boat Series General Sailing Instructions

CLASS	TIME
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PHRF A	1100 WARNING
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Combined Viper/Melges 24 Fleet (Started and scored together, racing level)

PHRF B/C	(Started and scored together)
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PHRF Non-Spin	(2 headsails allowed)
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PHRF CRUISING (Spin & Non-Spin) + ORC Performance Cruising (Started together, but scored separately)

TIME LIMIT

11.1 The time limit for the second boat in each fleet to finish is 2.5 hours from the start of that fleet. If fewer than two boats have finished within the Time Limit, the race shall be abandoned for that fleet. Boats still racing but not finished at the Time Limit will be scored DNF.

PROTESTS

12.1 Protests must be submitted in writing within one hour of the Race Committee arriving at HYC dock.

AWARDS/SOCIAL

Daily awards and beverages will be given following racing each day at HYC Gazebo. Overall Perpetual and Series awards will be given at the annual HYC Awards Party in December.
