



# NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. Races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2025-2028* (RRS) and the prescriptions of the Santana One Design Association.
- 1.2. Races will be started in accordance with RRS 26.
- 1.3. RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear life jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy while racing." Flag Y may not be displayed.
- 1.4. RRS Appendix T1, *Post Race Penalties*, will apply.
- 1.5. RRS Appendices T2, T3, and T4 pertaining to arbitration, will apply.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The series is open to members of Stillwater Yacht Club, members of the Santana One Design Association, and other competitors as may be approved by the Organizing Authority.
- 2.2. The designated skipper of each yacht will enter by completing the registration form available online at [sycpb.org/regattas](http://sycpb.org/regattas) no later than 0800 hours on the day of the first race.
- 2.3. All participants are required to complete SYC's online *Release and Assumption of Risk* form prior to the Competitors' Meeting on the first day of racing.

### 3. FEES

- 3.1. There is a \$65 entry fee payable at the time of registration.

### 4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. This is a multi-day event with races scheduled for 8/01/26 and 8/02/26.  
Three (3) races using Class sails are planned for 8/01; one (1) race using genoas and spinnakers is planned for 8/02.

- 4.2. Daily schedule:
  - 4.2.1. Competitors' Meeting: 1030 hours (Stillwater Pier)
  - 4.2.2. First warning signal: 1155 hours
- 4.3. The Race Committee reserves the right to make changes to the racing schedule.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available on Stillwater Yacht Club's website (sycpb.org) and at the Competitors' Meeting.

**6. SAIL RESTRICTIONS**

- 6.1. In races 1-3, competitors will use mains and jibs only (no genoas or spinnakers).

**7. VENUE**

- 7.1. The racing area will be in Carmel Bay.

**8. COURSES**

- 8.1. The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

**9. SCORING**

- 9.1. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2. A minimum of one (1) race must be completed to constitute a series and award prizes.

**10. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

- 10.1. The Race Committee intends to communicate on marine VHF channel 68.

**11. PRIZES**

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded for the three-race series using Class sails and for the Open Race.

**12. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

- 12.1. By participating in the Santanarama, a competitor automatically grants the Organizing Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any still or motion pictures of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

**13. Social Events**

- 13.1. There will be a dinner on Stillwater Pier on 8/01. The starting time will be 1700 hrs. Tickets for the event may be purchased for \$40 on the regatta website. (No charge for Children under 12.) If three races are completed, trophies for Saturday's races will be awarded at the dinner.
- 13.2. A final awards ceremony will be held on Stillwater Pier following Sunday's race(s).
