## Notice of Race

### 1. RULES

1.1 This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2020-2024 ([www.sailing.org](http://www.sailing.org)) to the extent permitted by Part 7 of the RRS, specific provisions of the RRS may be modified, altered or made inoperative by the Notice of Race (NOR) or the Sailing Instructions (SI).

1.2 Rules of participating ONE DESIGN (Optimist, ILCA, 420) classes will apply, except as modified, altered or made inoperative by the NOR or the SI, to the extent permitted by such class rules.

1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

### 2. ENTRIES, REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Entries will be limited to Optimist (Advance, Green, Super Green Fleet and Red, Blue and White), ILCA 4, ILCA 6, 420.

2.3 Registration fee will be the following.

2.5 For a registration to be considered complete payment of the fee must be done and date of payment will be applied.

2.6 All skippers must sign the waivers.

#### 3.2 Skippers check in and Registration

3.2.1 NO registrations will be taken after Friday August 5, 2022 at 1030 hrs.

3.2.2 All competitors must complete registration before the Skipper's meeting.

#### 3.3 Skipper's Meeting and Coaches Meeting

3.3.1 The Skipper's Meeting will take place at the "Academia de Vela" premises at 1030 hrs. on Friday August 5, 2022.

#### 3.4 Races

3.4.1 Races will be back to back.

3.4.2 Races will start on Friday August 5, 2022 at 1200hrs,

3.4.3 Saturday August 6 and Sunday August 7, 2022 at 1100hrs.

3.4.4 No warning signal will be hoisted after 1600 hours on Friday August 5 and Saturday August 6, 2022.

3.4.5 No warning signal will be hoisted after 1400 hrs. on Sunday August 7, 2022.

### 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 This is a Green Regatta and competitors may print their own SI's. Sailing Instructions will be online prior to the event at [www.theclubspot.com](http://www.theclubspot.com). A copy will be posted in the Official Bulletin Board.

### 5. VENUE

5.1 The venue will be the San Juan Bay and its surrounding waters.

### 6. THE COURSE

6.1 The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward. If conditions warrant, the courses will be modified to accommodate the appropriate wind conditions.

6.2 The green fleet will be given their courses at the skippers meeting

## **8. SCORING**

8.1 A minimum of one (1) race will constitute a regatta.

8.2 The Low Point System (A4) will apply.

8.3 When less than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.4 When from six (6) to eleven (11) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her (1) worst score.

8.5 When from twelve (12) to fifteen (15) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores.

## **9. ADVERTISING**

9.1 ISAF regulation 20.4 applies. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

## **10. AWARDS PRESENTATIONS.**

10.1. The awards presentations for the Pan Pepin International Dinghy Regatta will be held at the Academia de Vela on Sunday August 7, 2022 at 1600 hrs.

10.2 Trophies will be given for first, second and third place in the Red, Blue and White Optimist classes as well as the top three overall and top place female. Participation Awards will be given to all Opti Super Green and Opti Green sailors.

10.3. In the Laser Class, trophies will be given to the top three of each division, ILCA 4, ILCA 6 & 420.

## **11. DISCLAIMER LIABILITY CLAUSE**

Competitors participating in the regatta are entirely at their own risk. Competitors agree to be bound by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by Sailing Instruction (SI), the Notice of Race (NOR) and any additional information to the SI or to the NOR. Competitors agree to take any responsibility for nautical qualities of their yacht, the rigging, the crew ability and safety requirements. Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for damages caused to third persons (bodily injury included but not limited thereto) or their belongings, to themselves (bodily injury included but not limited thereto) or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the regatta, relieving of any responsibility The Club Nautico de San Juan and all his members, the sponsors and all persons involved in the organization under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for their behavior and dress of yacht's crew, representative and guest. Competitors are to be acquainted with RRS Part 1 Fundamental Rule 4: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone". In any case, competitors agree that The Club Nautico de San Juan Organization, the sponsors and their agents, have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members or others or for the loss of, or damage to any vessel or property. As part of the registration process, each individual participating crewmember will be required to sign a declaration accepting this disclaimer of liability.

## **12. RIGHT TO USE AND LIKENESS**

12.1 By participating in Pan Pepin International Dinghy Regatta a competitor automatically grants the Organizing Committee and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the competitor during the period of the Pan Pepin International Dinghy Regatta, without compensation.
