Notice of Race (NoR)

[NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1 and 63.2(a)

1. **RULES**

1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025 - 2028.

1.2. RRS 40.1 applies and is amended so that it applies at all times while afloat.

1.3. A boat that sails with a sail number she is not registered with, or without permission of the race committee, will receive a 20% scoring penalty, calculated as described in RRS 44.3(c), applied to each race in which she sails in breach, without a hearing. **[NP]**

2. **REGISTRATION**

2.1. All boats may register by completing the online entry form and paying the required fees by the entry deadline

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The 2026 Saskatoon Sailing Club Annual Open Regatta is open to all classes.
- 4.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration process.
- 4.3. After 10:00AM on June 27th 2026, no new registrations will be accepted.
- 4.4. Five or more boats of the same class registered and paid will be scored as a fleet.
- 4.5. Classes with fewer than five entries may be combined into an open fleet at the discretion of the organizing authority (no handicap correction applied). **[NP]**.
- 4.6. ILCA 4, ILCA 6 and ILCA 7 sailors that are competing for the ILCA District 5 series must be current members of ILCA North America. Non-members can join the class by completing registration online at <https://ilcanasailing.org/membership>
- 4.7. ILCA-NA membership is required only for District 5 series scoring, not for participation in the regatta.

5. FEES

- 5.1. Single Handed Regatta Only \$60.00
- 5.2. Double Handed Regatta Only \$65.00

5.3. Sailors who are registered class members of ILCA North America will receive a 50% discount on registration.

5.4. Late Registration is available on-site at the Regular Registration rate on Saturday morning, though it may not include all the same benefits as an advanced Online registration.

6. VENUE

Racing will take place on the waters of Redberry Lake, Saskatchewan.

7. COURSES

The courses sailed will be windward/leeward. Specific details will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

8. SCHEDULE

9. SCORING

9.1. Three races are required to constitute a series

9.2. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9.3. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be her total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9.4. Nine races are scheduled

9.5. To be scored as an ILCA-NA Grand Prix class event the following minimum ILCA-NA members competitors must be registered

9.5.1. ILCA 7 - Seven boats

9.5.2. ILCA 6 – Seven boats

9.5.3. ILCA 4 – Five boats

10. PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded.

- 10.1. **Commodore's Cup** will be awarded to the winner of the first race on Sunday in the largest fleet.
- 10.2. **Kingsmill Cup** will be awarded to the overall regatta winner
- 10.3. **Top 3 awards** in each class.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, *Decision to Race*. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The organising authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a boat has valid third-party liability insurance **[NP]**.

13. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in this event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the event without compensation.
