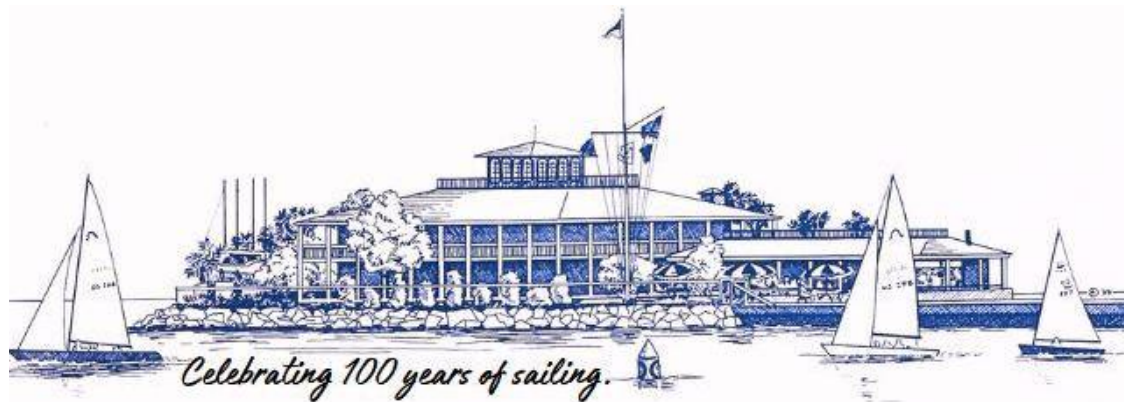

NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is

Alamitos Bay Yacht Club (ABYC)



The notation '[SP]' in a *rule* in the Notice of Race (NoR) refers to a standard penalty that may be applied by the race committee without a hearing for a breach of a specific rule.

1. SCHEDULE

- 1.1. Number of Races: 4 races are scheduled.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The event is governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2. Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: A *protest* is invalid (2) it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was neither involved in nor saw the incident, or
- 2.3. The US Sailing prescriptions are available at <https://www.ussailing.org/competition/rules-officiating/racing-rules/>
- a) The US Prescription to rule 63.1(b) is deleted.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. The sailing instructions will be after **1800 on Sunday, 11 October 2026** available on the official notice board.

4. COMMUNICATION

- 4.1. The official notice board is located online at <https://abyc.org/regatta/YOxgPfTNwZ/#notice-board>.

5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1. The event is open to boats of the Naples Sabot class, racing in Ladies A, Ladies B, Men A, and Mixed C divisions. Competitors must have reached their 18th birthday. To establish a class, five paid entries are needed. If a class does not meet this requirement by the early entry deadline, it may be combined with another class.
- 5.2. Classes may be started together but scored separately.
- 5.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at <https://abyc.org/regatta/YOxgPfTNwZ/> and submitting it, together with the required entry fee by **1800 October 17, 2026**. Entries will only be accepted after that at the discretion of the regatta organizers.
- 5.4. A boat shall be entered by a member in good standing of a club affiliated to US Sailing or other World Sailing member national authority, or a member of a World Sailing member national authority. (see RRS 75)
- a) ABYC members are eligible for a discounted US Sailing membership through [ABYC/US Sailing Member Partner Program](#).
- 5.5. The skipper (Person in Charge see RRS 46) of a boat shall accept and agree to the terms and conditions of the Regatta Waiver and Release of Liability as part of online registration.
- 5.6. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 5.7. The Ladies Day (and Gents) Regatta is the 4th regatta in the 2026 SCWSA five regatta series. It is open to adult sailors (18 years and up) who race Naples Sabots and all are encouraged to become members SCWSA and INSA.

6. FEES

- 6.1. The entry fee includes a light post-race dinner, launching, recovery, and storage for visiting competing boats from the day prior to the event until the day following the event.
- 6.2. Boats or trailers not paying yard storage fees that wish to arrive before the **earliest arrival date** or depart after the

latest departure date must complete an application for ABYC temporary yard storage. Applications can be completed at (<https://abyc.org/register/regatta/Gnq94CMgIX/class>). The application must be approved, the fee paid, and the waiver completed before arrival.

- 6.3. Any boat or trailer found on ABYC property without prior written authorization from ABYC is subject to impound and associated fees.
- 6.4. If an entry is cancelled by emailing regattas@abyc.org or calling +1 (562) 434-9955 by 1000 on the day of the event, the entry fee will be refunded less credit card and other processing fees.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. The event venue will be Alamitos Bay Yacht Club.
- 7.2. The racing area will be Alamitos Bay.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.2. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.3. Rule 90.3(e) applies.

9. RISK STATEMENT

- 9.1. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue racing is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**
- 9.2. The organizing authority including the sponsors, the race committee, the officers, directors, employees and members of the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club and all those involved in these organizations will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

10. DEPICTION RELEASE

- 10.1. Competitors, by competing in this event, grant to Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, perpetually and irrevocably, the unconditional and exclusive right, title and interest throughout the world to use, simulate and portray Participant's name, likeness, voice, personality, personal identification and personal experiences, incidents, situations and events, whether visual and/or audio, including without limitation photographs, videotape, film and other recordings, electronic or optical-based media, or any other form or medium whatsoever, whether now or hereafter existing, and of every kind and character (collectively "The Images"), which may be taken or taken of Participant while participating in any aspect of the event.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each division: Ladies A, Ladies B, Men A, and Mixed C.
- 11.2. The following perpetual trophies will be awarded:
