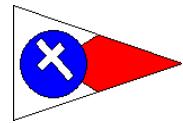

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. RRS40.1 applies, each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device.

2. Notice to Competitors

- 2.1. Notices to Competitors may be posted online on the SCYC Clubspot Notice Board.

- 2.2. On the water, the Race Committee may use VHF channel 68 for communication.
- 2.3. Ashore, signals may be flown from the Regatta shed mast flagpole.

3. Eligibility, Divisions, and Entry

- 3.1. Boats holding a valid 2026 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate are eligible to enter this event.
- 3.2. There will be seven PHRF divisions as follows:
 1. DH Moore 24 Road Master Series
 2. Double Handed Spinnaker
 3. Double Handed Jib & Main
 4. Family Spinnaker
 5. Family Jib & Main
 6. Mix & Match Foursome Spinnaker
 7. Mix & Match Foursome Jib & Main
- 3.3. All boats are encouraged to have at least one female crew, but it is not required.
Final division assignments will be announced at the competitors' meeting.
- 3.4. Eligible boats may only enter by completing the online entry form for the event at
<https://scyc.org/regatta/PqBzdzZoFb> before 1130 hours Friday, October 23, 2026.
- 3.5. The entry fee is \$60.00 if registered by 2200 hours on Wednesday, October 21, 2026.
The late entry fee of \$75.00 is applied to all entries received after 2200 hours on Wednesday, October 21, 2026.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. A competitors' meeting will be held at 1030 hours on Saturday, October 24, 2026.
The meeting will be held at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club, upstairs main room.
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3. One race is scheduled. One race will constitute a Regatta.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be posted on-line prior to 1130 hours on Friday, October 23, 2026.

6. Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 3.5-mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7. Courses

- 7.1 Courses will be distributed with the Sailing Instructions.

8. Prizes

- 8.1 Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority and awarded at the SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.
- 8.2 A regatta winning SCYC boat and owner/skipper in any division with three (3) or more entries with a current PHRF rating will be eligible to compete in the Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions Regatta.
