SAILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BAY

1. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.1. Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted at least 90 minutes prior to the first warning signal on the day it will take effect.

2. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 2.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole at Alamitos Bay Yacht Club.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1. The order of starts for the first race will be displayed near the Race Entry Room. The race committee may change the starting order of classes for subsequent races.

4. CLASS FLAGS

- 4.1. Code flag W will be the class flag for ALL classes, with the starting class and next starting class indicated by placards.



5. COURSES

- 5.1. The courses and description of marks are listed in Addendum A Course Diagrams.
5.2. The starting class and the selected course for that class will be displayed on the signal vessel.

6. MARKS

- 6.1. Marks X1, 2, 3s/3p are inflatable orange shapes.
6.2. Marks 1 is a inflatable yellow shapes.
6.3. Starting mark is a yellow shape.
6.4. Finishing mark is a blue inflatable shape.
6.5. Marks A, C, D, are Yellow permanent marks with a large letter designating the mark.

7. THE START

- 7.1. Races will be started using RRS 26 with the warning signal made 3 minutes before the starting signal. The preparatory signal displayed 2 minutes before the starting signal. This changes RRS 26.
Races will be started using Appendix U.
7.2. The starting line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel and the course side of the starting mark.
7.3. [DP] Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during the starting sequence for other races.
7.4. If any part of a boat's hull is on the course side of the starting line at her starting signal and she is identified, the race committee will attempt to

hail her sail number. A boat may not request redress based on failure of the race committee to hail her number, failure of her to hear such a hail, or the order in which boats are hailed. This changes RRS 61.1(a).

8. CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

- 8.1. Marks may be moved up to 10 degrees in bearing without a signal, provided the change is made prior to the lead boat beginning that leg of the course. This changes RRS 33.
8.2. To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will lay a new mark or move the finishing line and remove the original mark as soon as practicable. New Marks will be a different color. When in a subsequent change a new mark is replaced, it will be replaced with an original mark.

9. THE FINISH

- 9.1. The finishing line is between a staff displaying a blue flag on the signal vessel and the course side of the finishing mark.

10. TIME LIMITS

11. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 11.1. The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the signal vessel reaches the dock. The time will be posted on the official notice board.
11.2. Protests and requests for redress shall be filed electronically using the hearing request forms available at the Hearing Request Link on the Official Notice Board.
11.3. Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held in the protest room, beginning at the time posted.

12. SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 12.1. [DP] A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
12.2. Every boat racing shall have a painter suitable for towing, at least one boat length long.
