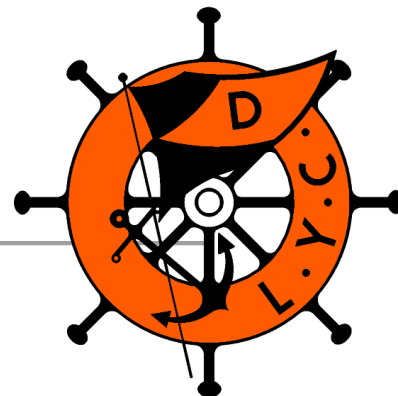

Eligibility

The regatta is open to all Flying Scot skippers who are current FSSA members. A boat may sail with a different sail number from its hull number if it registers with that sail number and competes with that number for the entire event. Each competitor must complete a registration form and pay the required fees by close of registration 0930 on August 15, 2026.

Rules

1. The races will be governed by the rules defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
2. The racing area will be the waters of Delavan Lake.
3. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be published and posted on the [official notice board](#).
4. VHF Radio will be used by the RC to communicate with competitors on the water. Additional instructions regarding radio communication will be included in the SI's.

Registration

Registration is \$150. Breakfast and lunches are included in the Regatta registration fee for the skipper and one crew. Extra lunches are \$15 each and can be purchased on site. Saturday dinner party at DLYC with live music on stage is included for the skipper and one crew. Extra dinners are \$25 each and can be purchased on site. Hats and T-shirts will be available for purchase at registration.

Scoring

Five races are scheduled. The Low Point system, RRS A4 will apply, except that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2.

Trophies

One race is required to be completed for the regatta to be official. In addition to FSSA trophies, keeper trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers and the highest finishing woman skipper.

Launching & Moorings

The regatta will be dry sailed or wet sailed. Boats can be ramp or crane launched.
