NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Tred Avon Yacht Club (TAYC) is the Organizing Authority.
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR)

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website approximately one week prior to the race date.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all Star Class boats. Stars must comply with Star Class Racing Association (STCR) 21 and 23.7.1. If a Novice Skipper (as defined by STCR 23.7.1), please identify yourself on entry form.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing-cal) and completing the entry form for the event. All registrations must be completed online.

4. FEES

- 4.1. The entry fee for a skipper and one crew is \$135, which is reduced from the fee of \$235 thanks to the sponsorship of **Charles Schwab**. The fee is payable in full upon online registration and is not refundable within one (1) week of the regatta. Entry fee includes Continental Breakfast Sat/Sun, Saturday Buffet Dinner and Sunday post-race hors d'oeuvres. The cash bar is always open. Additional information on pricing for entry fees, meals and other items will be posted on the event website as the race date approaches.
- 4.2. Additional crew must be listed at registration. Additional dinner tickets are available for purchase upon registration only - \$70 per person for Saturday Dinner only, or \$100 per person for Saturday Dinner and Sunday Awards which includes service fee, tax will be applied at checkout. Bagged lunches are available for purchase upon registration for \$12 plus tax and must be pre-ordered.

5. THE VENUE

- 5.1. Racing will be in the Tred Avon River or the Choptank River S/SW of the Choptank River Light, depending upon weather.

6. COURSES & PROCEDURES

- 6.1. Courses and Procedures will be in accordance with STCR 34.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 7.2. One race must be completed to constitute the regatta.
- 7.3. If more than 5 races are completed, a boat's worst score will be excluded from her total score.

8. LAUNCHING

- 8.1. Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers must be stored in designated areas clear of the hoist and access lanes. No vehicles may drive on dock.
- 8.2. Once launched, boats may haul-out after Saturday's racing or remain in the water overnight at TAYC's docks.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows: 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall for the weekend.
- 9.2. Special prizes may also be awarded:
 - AB Streeton Trophy: Winning boat after Saturday's racing.
 - North Emory Bartlett Trophy: Winning boat for Sunday's races.
 - Novice Skipper: Best overall score among novice skippers.
- 9.3. Prizes will be presented at the TAYC clubhouse following Sunday's racing.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
