NOTICE OF RACE**

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 E-Scows will be required to race with Float Packs at the top of the mast.
- 1.3 Appendix V2 will apply
- 1.4 The Prescriptions RRS 63.1 and RRS 63.2 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all one-design boats with 4 or more boats registered.
- 2.2 ILCA/Laser class boats may register and sail as Full, Radial or 4.7. A boat must sail the regatta in the rig as registered.

Sunday, July 26	0900-1000 Breakfast, Under the Boathouse 1300 First Warning, other race(s) to follow. No races will be started after 1600. Awards Ceremony following the Protest Time Limit, Ft. Sumter Ballroom



5. SOCIAL:

- Continental breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning.
- Commodore's Reception 1900 on Saturday in the Bastion Ballroom. The Boathouse restaurant will be accepting credit cards during the regatta.

7. VENUE: Racing will be in Charleston harbor.

8. THE COURSES & CLASS FLAGS: The courses will be "around the buoys" and will be included in the Sailing Instructions. Class flags will be posted by 1100 Saturday.

9. POST RACE PENALTIES/PROTESTS: Appendix V, Section V2, Post–Race Penalties, will be in effect for this event.

10. SCORING:

10.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply. If less than 6 races are scored, a boat's total score is the sum of all races. If 6 or more are scored then a boat's total score will have one throw out.

10.1 An unlimited number of races are scheduled. One race will constitute a regatta.

12. AWARDS:

- Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of boats competing in each Class.
- Recipients of the CYC Philip O/Neal Hanvey Memorial, Henry Clay Robertson IV Trophy will be awarded at the awards ceremony.
