Notice of Race

INVITATION: Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club and Santana 22 One Design Association (SODA) Fleet #12 invite you to the 2026 Santana 22 National Championship to sail the challenging waves and breezes of beautiful Monterey Bay.

Rules: The regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the rules of the Santana 22 One Design Class, and this Notice of Race, except as any of these are modified by the Sailing Instructions.

Entry and Fees: The regatta is open to all members in good standing of their local Santana 22 Association. Entries shall be made on-line using the MPYC event website: <https://mpyc.org/register/regatta/DqmsmMgkGJ/class>. Each boat owner must complete an entry form, sign the MPYC Release of Liability Waiver, and pay the entry fee.

Participating boats shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Boat owners are solely responsible for ensuring that such coverage is current and adequate.

The entry fee shall be paid online at the time of registration. The regatta entry fee is \$150. The entry form, waiver and fee must be received by Friday July 10, 2026, after which a late fee of \$25.00 will apply.

Each registration packet includes one Saturday night buffet dinner, one Santana 22 Nationals cap, and three house beer, wine or cocktail tickets. Additional buffet dinner tickets can be purchased in advance online.

Each visiting skipper and their crew and guests are invited to the Friday evening dinner at MPYC. In addition, there will be a buffet dinner for all racers and guests on Saturday night. This will commence immediately following the annual SODA meeting that will start at 6:00 pm in the dining room.

Notices to competitors will also be posted on the MPYC Regatta Notice Board at the clubhouse entrance.

Measurement: Each yacht shall submit proof, when requested by the Race Committee, of holding a valid measurement certificate. Fleet #12 Measurer or their alternate will perform measurement of unmeasured sails. For an appointment Contact Justin Nielson at: jtn644@gmail.com or 831-747-4597.

Number of Races: The Santana 22 National Championship Regatta will consist of five races. A minimum of three races is required to constitute a regatta.

Scoring: The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A, will apply. There shall be NO THROW OUTS.

Safety: In addition to USCG required equipment, each yacht shall carry at least the minimum safety equipment described in the Santana 22 Class Constitution and Rules:

Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club requires all competitors to wear a PFD while on the water at all club-sponsored events. This requirement shall be in effect during the entire regatta. The Y flag will not be displayed.

All boats shall carry a VHF radio. The race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio channel 68.

It shall be the sole responsibility of each yacht to decide whether to start or continue to race.

Number of Crew: Each yacht must carry the same number of crew for each race in the regatta. The number of crew is left to the discretion of each skipper. Per SODA rules, each yacht shall carry a minimum of two crew.

Launching, Mooring and Haul outs: A hoist is available adjacent to MPYC for a fee. Hoist assistance will be available. Please prepurchase hoist tickets on the registration web site. A launch ramp is available in Monterey Harbor and at the nearby Coast Guard Pier. Please check in with our concierge prior to launching or hoisting your boat. Visiting yachts may raft up in front of the yacht club or arrange with the Monterey Harbormaster for a slip. All yachts must remain in the water during the regatta. Haul outs will only be allowed at the conclusion of racing on Sunday. Yachts requiring haul out due to damage must receive approval from the Principal Race Officer (PRO).

Vehicle and Trailer Parking: The MPYC boatyard has limited space for trailers. Trailer parking will be available in the MPYC boatyard on a first-come first-served basis. Please contact Jeff Carder at jtcarder@comcast.net or 775-420-2400 if you would like to request a trailer spot in the boatyard.

Vehicle and trailer parking is available in the Municipal Wharf area near the Yacht Club. You can use the ParkMobile app or the "Pay Here Kiosks" to pay for parking from 9 am to 8 pm daily. Parking a vehicle with a boat trailer requires paying for one space for the vehicle and one space for the trailer. Paid automobile parking is also available in nearby Monterey city lots.

Awards: First through fifth place trophies will be awarded, as well as the Santana 22 Class Perpetual Trophy.

Additional Information:

To save time and effort for participants, breakfast burritos and a make-your-own bag lunch bar will be available each morning of the regatta for pre-purchase only. Please order these items at the time of registration so we can ensure that enough quantity is available. Merchandise, extra dinner tickets and hoist tickets are also available for pre-purchase online at the event registration site.
