Notice of Race

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta is Coronado Yacht Club (CYC).

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2.2. The US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2, and 63.4 will not apply.
- 2.3. Finn Class Rule C.1.1 will be in effect.
- 2.4. Per Finn Class Rule A.7.2, rule C.1.1 (2) will be amended to 8 knots.
- 2.5. RRS 40 – PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES will be in effect from the moment you leave the dock until the moment you return. No Y flag will be flown ashore.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all Finn Class sailboats, limited to 40 paid entries
- 3.2. Registration will be through Clubspot, <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/dEmchJcLsv>
- 3.3. An entry will be considered complete only when the online entry form is submitted and regatta entry fees paid.
- 3.4. Entries will close at 1800 Thursday September 10, 2026.

4. ADVERTISING

Advertising shall be permitted in accordance with World Sailing Advertising Code.

5. FEES (this includes one dinner ticket on Saturday night).

- 5.1. Entry fee through September 1, 2026 = \$100
Late entry fee September 2 – September 10, 2026 = \$120
- 5.2. Boat storage at CYC is complementary from Thursday, September 10 through Monday, Sept. 14, 2026. Also, Finns can enter and sail the CYC small boat regatta Sept 26 & 27, 2026. If entered into the CYC small boat regatta, storage fees will be waved, but boats must be removed by end of day on Sept 27, 2026. Prior to keeping any boat at CYC permission is required and a tag to be placed on the Trailer.
- 5.3. Dinner is included for one skipper, for others please buy a dinner ticket for \$45.00.



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6. SCHEDULE

6.1. A maximum of Five (5) races to be sailed three (3) Saturday and Two (2) Sunday.

6.2. The schedule of events is as follows:

1600 Fun Finn races in Glorietta Bay just off of CYC,
with Finn tuning tips from Darryl Peck. Start boat will be provided.

Sunday, September 13, 2026:

1255 1st Warning Signal

1630 No further Warning Signal shall be made

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. Sailing instructions will be available at the CYC Notice Board and online at the regatta website.

7.2. The Official notice board is located CYC notice board by the front office.

8. VENUE

8.1. Inside the South San Diego Bay.

9. SCORING

9.1. The Low Point Scoring system will apply except that no scores will be excluded if fewer than five (5) races are completed. This changes RRS A2.

9.2. Three (3) races shall be completed to constitute a series.

10. AWARDS

10.1 PCC Champion will be awarded the Perpetual PCC Trophy to remain at SDYC.

10.2 Trophies will be awarded for top 3 - 5 finishers overall depending on number of entries.

11. PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

12. Competitors entering the regatta accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using Coronado Yacht Club's facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitors name or not without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.



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13. COACHES AND NON-RACE COMMITTEE BOATS

- 13.1. All boats and coaches must be capable of communicating with the Race Committee on VHF channels 16, 68, 69, 71 and 73.

14. INSURANCE

- 14.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with minimum coverage of US \$300,000.00 per event or the equivalent.
