NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. The Organizing Authority is the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.
- 2.2 For all classes, Rules 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced with a One-Turn penalty.
- 2.3 US Sailing Prescriptions to 63.1 will not apply

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all Harbor 20, Finn & Lehman 12 boats.
- 2.2. Skippers must be members in good standing with their respective yacht club and their respective class association to be eligible to sail in this event.
- 2.3. The Harbor 20's will sail in three divisions: A, B and C. Finn's & Lehman 12 fleets will each be one division.
- 2.4. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying \$20 for H20 and L12 or \$15 for Finn's. Completed entry forms must be filed with Newport Harbor Yacht Club before 1200 on September 26, 2026.
- 2.5. A competitor is not entered and will not receive a score until all fees are paid.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club on Saturday, September 26, 2026.

5. VENUE

Racing will be in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 6.2 When four (4) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7. PRIZES

- 7.1. Prizes will be awarded Saturday, September 26, 2026 as soon as possible after the last race. The Fall One Design Perpetual trophy will be awarded to the winning teams in Harbor 20 A, B & C fleets.

8. DISCLAIMER

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race.
