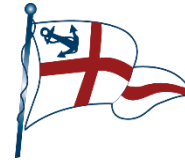


**2026 Friday Nite Flites

1. RULES

- 1.1 Each Series will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
1.2 US Sailing prescriptions 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted. 1.3 No protests will be allowed. This changes RRS 60.1.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- 2.1 Each monthly series is open to all Harbor 20, Lasers, CFJs, RS Zests & RS Teras. Other classes may be added upon Race Committee approval.
2.3 Eligible boats may enter online at www.liyc.net/friday-nite-flites by completing the entry form prior to a boat's first race. Eligible boats need only enter once to be included in the remaining 2026 Nite Flites races.
2.2 Sail number changes must be reported to the Race Committee boat prior to racing with the new sail number.

3. SCHEDULE

Series Month	Dates	First Warning Signal
Series 1	June 19 th , 26 th and July 17 th	5:30pm
Series 2	July 24 th , 31 st and August 7 th	5:30pm
Series 3	August 14 th , 21 st and 28 th	5:30pm

4. COURSES

Start and Finish Line will be in Newport Harbor in the Lido Channel. The courses for all classes will use fixed marks with the exception of temporary U, which will be an orange ball. Course charts will be available online or from the Race Committee boat. Courses will be posted on the Race Committee Boat.

5. SCORING

- 5.1 Each series will be scored separately.
5.2 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A4. Three (3) races shall be completed to constitute a series.

When 'X' number of races have been completed	A boat's series score will be the total of her races scores excluding 'X' number of scores
4 or fewer	0
5-7	1
8-10	2
11 or more	3

6. PRIZES There are no trophies awarded for these series.
