NOTICE OF RACE – AD HOC SUNDAY RACES

1. Rules, Eligibility and Event Classification

- 1.1 The regattas will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025-2028.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 is applicable as follows: each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.
- 1.3 Boats with three or fewer persons aboard may use autopilots and powered winches. This modifies RRS 52.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Races are open to any Boats with a valid Northern California PHRF certificate.
- 2.2 Those boats without certificates will be assigned a PHRF rating at the sole and un-appealable discretion of the Race Committee.
- 2.3 Eligible boats must enter on jibeset.net (Coyote Point YC), on the website of Coyote Point Yacht Club at cpyc.com, or attend the skipper's meeting prior to the race to be scored - questions please contact regatta@cpyc.com or call 650-207-5267.
- 2.4 All skippers and crew must sign a waiver and release of liability and turn it in to the Regatta Chair in person at the skipper's mail or prior to the race via regatta@cpyc.com.

3. Entry fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are as follows: \$10 per race day (waived for CPYC members).
- 3.2 Late registration will be held on-site at CPYC's Regatta Room at 12:00 noon.

4. Schedule of Races

- 4.1 The following races will be held on the dates listed below:
10/18/26; 11/15/26; 11/29/26; 12/6/26; 12/20/26.
- 4.2 The scheduled time for the first Warning Signal, if any, is 12:55 hours.
- 4.3 Skippers' Meeting will be held at 12:00 noon in the club's Regatta Room.
Races begin at 1:00 p.m.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions, if any, will be available online at jibeset.net. The Sailing Instructions, if any, will also be made available at the CPYC club house on the day of the race by 12:00 noon. The course for each race is generally given at the Skippers' meeting.

6. Venue

6.1 The race will be sailed in the South Bay Water of San Francisco Bay located in the general area east of CPYC and between mark B and mark 8.

7. Courses

7.1 The courses may include either or both Temporary and Fixed Marks.

8. Scoring

8.1 The Time on Time Scoring method will be used unless the race is a pursuit race. If it is a pursuit race, this will be announced at the skippers' meeting.

9. Results

9.1 Results may be posted at jibeset.net, may be posted on the website of Coyote Point Yacht Club at cpyc.com. Results will be emailed or texted to participants.

10. Disclaimer of Liability

10.1 Competitors participate in the race or races entirely at their own risk.

See Rule 3, Decision to Race (RRS).

10.2 RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS

For and in consideration of the acceptance by the Coyote Point Yacht Club of my participation in the above race(s), I hereby accept all the risks and responsibilities of my participation in said race(s) and waive to the fullest extent permitted by law any and all claims I may have against the Coyote Point Yacht Club, its members, officers, directors, committees, agents and/or employees arising out of or in any way connected with such participation. I agree to abide by this Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions of this regatta, the Rules of the US Sailing Association, the Racing Rules of Sailing and by the Rules of the Host Organization. I further expressly agree that the forgoing release and waiver is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by law and that if any portion, clauses or sub-clauses hereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full force and legal effect.

11. Insurance

11.1 Each participating boat shall have third-party liability insurance.
