Notice of Regatta

2026 FALL SERIES (The Rum Challenge)

PHRF - Sept 2, 9, 16, 23, 30, Oct 7, 14

J/70 - Sept 3, 10, 17, 24, Oct 1, 8, 15

1. RULES

- 1.1 The U.S. Sailing Association's Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 edition will govern this regatta.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 All competitors must:
- 2.1a Be members in good standing of Breakwater Yacht Club.
 - 2.1b Have paid the entry fee.
 - 2.1c Have boat insurance covering racing.
 - 2.1d Have acquired a current ELIYA/ECSA PHRF certificate prior to or within one week of competing in their first race.
- 2.2 Visiting boats may enter at a cost of \$25.00 per individual race but will not be scored for the series.
- 2.3 Eligibility to race for visiting boats is up to the discretion of the Regatta Committee.
- 2.4 **No Competitor will be scored without fulfilling all eligibility requirements prior to the race.**

3. FEES

- 3.1 \$185
- 3.2 All fees need to be paid through the Breakwater website Racing page <https://breakwateryc.org/phrf>

4. DIVISIONS for PHRF boats

- 4.1 Division I: Spinnaker boats having PHRF of 150 or less
- 4.2 Division II: Spinnaker boats having PHRF of 151 or more
- 4.3 Division III: Non-Spinnaker boats
- 4.4 Division IV: Club Class (Pursuit starts)
- 4.5 The Race Committee reserves the right to classify certain boats as it sees fit.

5. COURSES

- 5.1 All races will be run in Shelter Island Sound.
- 5.2 Courses will be displayed from a board on the committee boat.

6. START

The start shall be in the area west of Majors Cove in Shelter Island Sound. The first gun at 6:00pm local time for the 1st Wednesday, at 5:30pm for the next race day in September, and at 5:00pm for all the race days after that, unless skippers are notified of a different start time by email at least by Monday morning prior to the race in question.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 For each division, the low point scoring system (U.S. Sailing rules Appendix A – using A5.2 and A5.3 modified to count DNS, NSC, DNF, RET, DSQ, and OSC as scored equal to the number of series boats coming to the starting area and keeping DNC scored as 1 more than the number of boats entered in the series) will be used.
- 7.2 A boat's best scores for 70% of the races run, rounded normally to a whole number, will be counted to score the series.

8. PRIZES

Prizes of rum will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each division with at least 3 boats entered there (unless skippers are under age of 21, otherwise a trophy).

9. CHANGES

Changes to the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions may be posted on the Regatta Notice Board, and Skippers may be notified by email.
