

Race Course/Traffic Safety Sheet

As you head out to the race course, please be advised that you must cross one of the busiest shipping channels on the East Coast.

Things to keep in mind:

- Cross the channel as a group, preferably near G17/R18
- There is active dredge work in the vicinity of R18, avoid dredge barges
- While near the channel, or crossing the channel, monitor VHF Channels 13/16
- Container ships and barges will not, and CANNOT stop for you
- Look both ways, and advise your sailors to look both ways when crossing the channel
- When approaching G17, keep an eye out for ships entering and exiting Norfolk International Terminal
- When approaching R18, be aware of active dredge work and avoid barges/tugs. Also look for dredge pipelines
