1 RULES The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.1 Racing rule(s) 4, 26, 33,35, 40, 44.1, 44.2, 61.2(d) and 61.3.will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 ADVERTISING This is a “Category A” event for advertising on Sabots (no advertising)

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Junior Naples Sabot Class and Snipe Class.

3.2 All Sabots and Snipes must be current class members. Membership will be verified on the online registration. If you are not current class members, you will be able to join on the registration page.

3.4 Fees: the registration fee shall be \$35 for Sabots and \$45 for Snipes. Fees cover sailing, after race snacks and trophies. Registrations received after Friday, March 18th shall be an additional \$10.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS The Sailing Instructions will be available online. Course charts will be available for all competitors.

6 VENUE Racing will take place in the Sail Bay portion of Mission Bay. Sabot C-3 and C-2 sailors will race in “Chicken Cove”.

- 7 THE COURSES** The courses will be displayed in the sailing instructions.
- 8 PENALTY SYSTEM** For all classes rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one jibe, is required, except that a two turns penalty shall be required for any Part 2 Rules foul (s) committed inside the zone (three boat lengths) of any turning mark.
- 9 SCORING** The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10 SUPPORT BOATS** Support boats shall be prominently marked with the burgee or boat name of the appropriate club or sailing organization. Support boats shall be required to monitor the appropriate Race Committee VHF channel 71 and respond as requested.
- 11 BERTHING** Park trailers against the west fence.
- 12 RADIO COMMUNICATION** A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 13 PRIZES** Prizes will be given as follows: the top five boats in each Sabot fleet and top 3 in the Snipe Fleet.
- 14 RISK** It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
- 15 PETS** Please leave your pets home; MBYC does not accommodate visiting dogs.
