



KEY BISCAYNE YACHT CLUB 2023 ANNUAL REGATTA May 20 and 21, 2023

NOTICE OF RACE

Key Biscayne Yacht Club (KBYC) will host its Annual One Design Regatta on Saturday, May 20th, and its Annual Cruising Regatta on Sunday, May 21st, 2023. KBYC is the organizing authority and host club.

Sailing Instructions: Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*, except as modified and supplemented by the current *Biscayne Bay Yacht Racing Association Sailing Instructions*. (Copies of the BBYRA Sailing Instructions are available at their website www.bbyra.org.) No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued.

Schedule of Races:

One-Design: Three races are scheduled on Saturday, May 20, 2022 and the first warning will be at 1130 hours. Entries are expected in the Etchells, J/24, J70, Snipe, Flying Scot and ILCA. Any class with three or more yachts are welcome. Advance Notice is appreciated. Pending the number of classes entered and the number of boats in the class, an additional circle may be implemented. Any change in this rule will be posted on the BBYRA and the KBYC website before May 19, 2023.

Cruising: First Warning signal is scheduled on Sunday, May 21, 2023, at 1130 using designated marks as outlined in BBYRA Cruising Sailing Instructions. Entries are expected in ORC, PHRF and ARC classes. Starting sequence will follow BBYRA format. (Boats needing a ORC rating certificate can go to: **www.orc.org/clubcertificate**) Boats needing a PHRF Handicap can go to: **<http://www.phrfsef.com/>**. ARC boats will be assigned a rating by the Organizing Authority.

Yacht Check-in: On race day, each yacht must check-in by sailing past the stern of the Race Committee boat on starboard tack prior to the warning signal of the first race in which it will be competing. No check-ins will be accepted during a starting sequence.

Registration: Boats registered in BBYRA are already entered. The Registration Form on the following page is required for yachts that are **not** registered with BBYRA.

One Design Classes registrations are due at KBYC not later than 1800 hours Friday, May 19, 2022, or in person between 0800 and 0930 hours on Saturday, May 20, 2023.

Cruising Boats (not registered with BBYRA), mail-in registration must be received by KBYC not later than 1800 hours Friday, May 19, 2023, or in person between 0800 and 0930 on Sunday, May 21, 2022. Boats needing an ORC certificate should contact rc@kbyc.org to request a temporary rating no later than Saturday May 20, 2022. For a permanent rating, visit www.ussailing.org.

Protests: Written protest or request for redress must be submitted within one hour after Race Committee Signal Boat Docks to the Race Committee. The Race Committee will post docking time and Race Committee Summary on the Official Notice Board at KBYC. This changes BBYRA Rule 15.2 and RRS 61.3.

Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place boats in all classes with at least five boats ranked as starting. A first place will be awarded to classes with less than five yachts ranked as starting.

Prizes will be awarded on the pool deck of KBYC for One Design on Saturday, May 20, 2023, after racing and for Cruising on Sunday, May 21, 2023 following racing.
