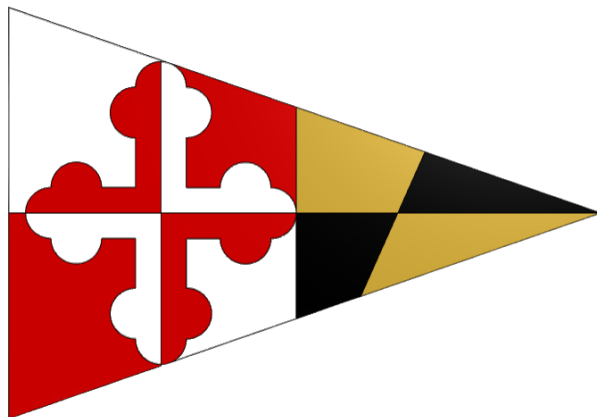

Windward/Leeward Course
18-19 July

Pg 4, 10.1:

(Was)

10.1 The windward mark will be an orange inflatable ball mark. Initial change marks will be orange inflatable tetrahedron. The port line starting mark will be a lime green cylinder or a Race Committee port line boat. The leeward mark will be a white cylinder. Finish marks will be a yellow tetrahedron.

(Is)

10.1 The windward mark will be an orange inflatable ball mark. Initial change marks will be an orange inflatable tetrahedron. The port line starting mark will be a **yellow inflatable ball** or a Race Committee port line boat. The leeward mark will be an **orange inflatable cylinder**. Finish marks will be a yellow inflatable tetrahedron.

11.5 Class Flags will be the #6 pennant for PHRF Spinnaker and a J Flag for the One Design J-70 class.



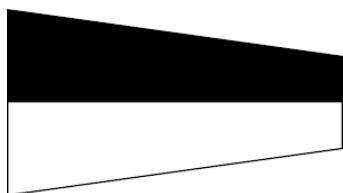
PHRF Spinnaker Class

Pg 5, 13.1:

(Was)

13.1 Course changes after the start will be made in accordance with RRS 33. The new mark will be a yellow inflatable ball for the first change. If a course that has been changed is changed again, the yellow inflatable ball will be replaced with an orange tetrahedron.

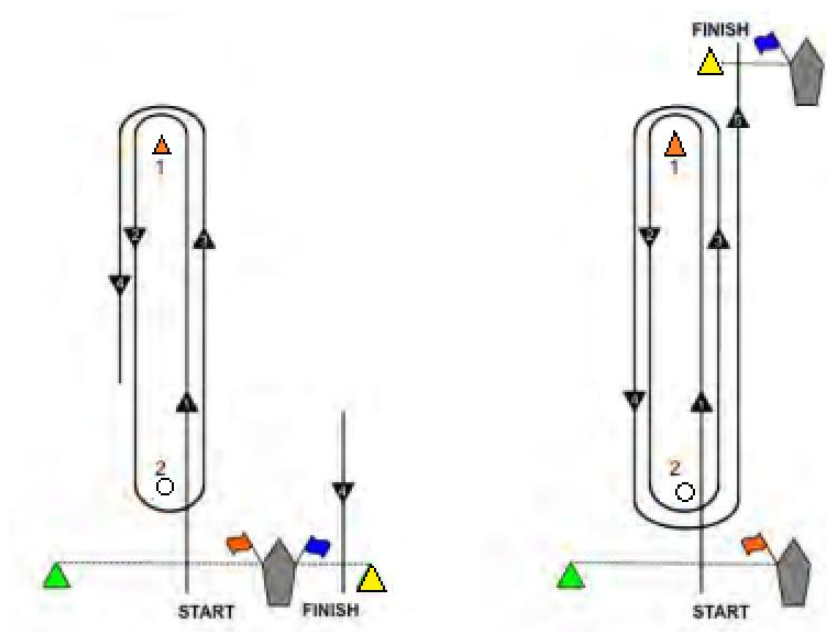

13.1 Course changes after the start will be made in accordance with RRS 33. The new mark will be a ***orange inflatable tetrahedron*** for the first change. If a course that has been changed is changed again, the ***orange inflatable tetrahedron*** will be replaced with an ***yellow inflatable ball***.

APPENDIX A

COURSE DIAGRAMS

All marks are to be rounded to port. For all courses, the leeward mark has no significance on the last leg of the course. For windward finishes, the windward mark has no significance on the last leg of the course and the finish line will be located to weather of the windward mark. The course designation will be equal to the number of legs to be sailed (Example: Course “4” is 4-legs, Course “5” is 5 legs, and Course “6” is 6 legs).



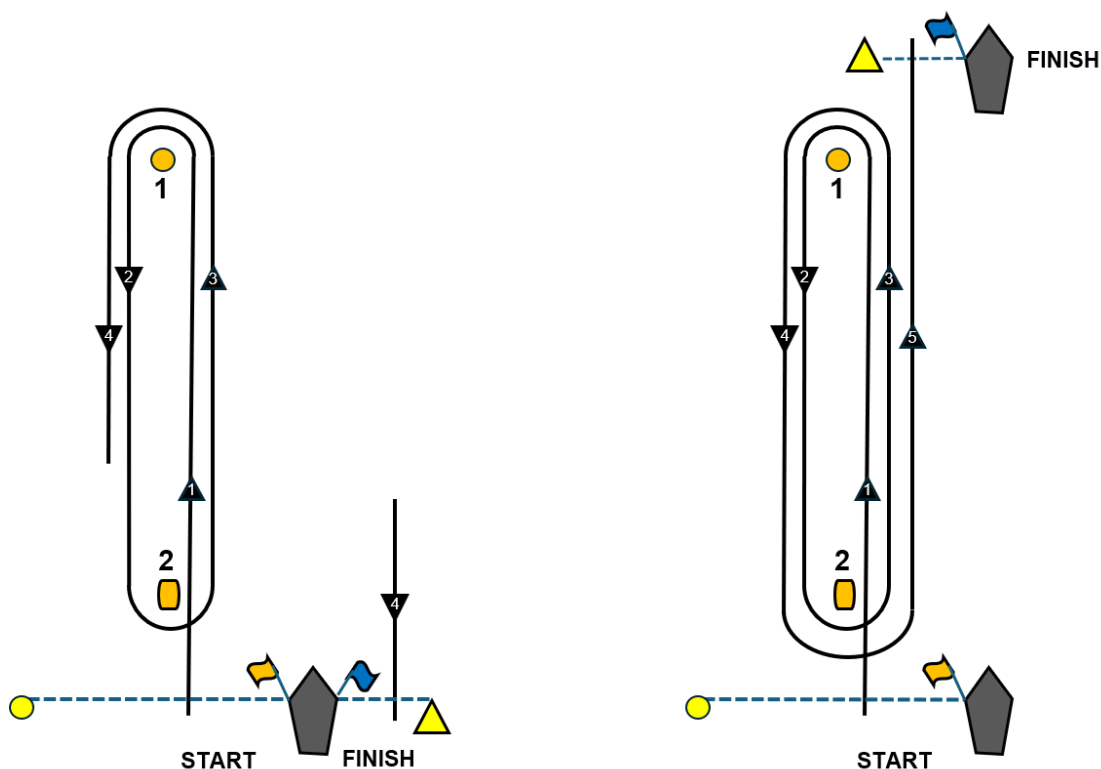
