1. DATE, ORGANIZING AUTHORITY & LOCATION

This event will be held on **Saturday, July 25th and Sunday, July 26th, 2026** by and at the Royal Lake of the Woods Yacht Club on Lake of the Woods, Ontario.

2. RULES

- a.** The regatta will be governed by
 - i.** The Racing Rules of Sailing, latest edition and;
 - ii.** The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association
 - iii.** The Sailing Instructions

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- a.** Sailing Instructions will be available before the 10:30 am Skippers Meeting.

4. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY AND FEES

- a.** Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying the entry fee of about **\$70 - \$80** per competitor depending on Boat Class.
- b.** The entry fee includes a shirt and hat, lunch and beverage each day, a BBQ on Saturday night and snacks on Sunday afternoon.

- c. The \$35 annual Sail Manitoba / Sail Canada registration fee is in addition to the entry fee for all skippers and crew (who have not previously paid it this summer).

	Lunch provided on water between races, and snacks will be provided at the Club after races.

6. SCORING

- a. The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. Each fleet will be scored separately. For the Richardson Regatta, positions will be determined based on each boat's corrected finishing time using the time-on-time Portsmouth Handicapping System.
- b. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
