NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the INSA class rules, and by the INSA Conditions for the Sabot II Championships. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 All boats must be Naples Sabots.
- 2.2 Competitors must have placed in the top 10 at the Sabot II South and North regattas to be eligible for the Championship.
- 2.3 All online entries must be submitted by 5pm, Tuesday July 16th, 2024. To register online please go to:

3. ENTRY FEE

- 3.1 \$25 (per boat)

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 Mandatory Check –In: All competitors must check-in Wednesday July 17th, 2024 between 9:30am-10:30am.

- 4.2 *** Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible after race one. There will be no scheduled lunch break.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be provided during Check-In on the day of the event.

6. VENUE AND COURSES

- 6.1 Boat launching: Coach Boats may be launched at MBYC Hoist.
- 6.2 Racing will take place in Sail Bay.
- 6.3 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

7. WEIGHTS

7.1 Skipper weights are not required for a Sabot II Championship event.

8. SCORING

8.1 Scoring will be in accordance with the RRS Appendix A.

9. TROPHIES

9.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race. Trophies will be awarded to the top 10 finishers.

10. DISCLAIMER

10.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
