

Notice of Race

San Juan21 Mid-Summer Regatta

18-19 July 2026

I. Rules

- A. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*
- B. Participants agree to abide by the RRS and all other rules that govern this event and those of the Host Club. Payment of the Entry Fee acknowledges agreement and consent to the rule requirement of this NOR.
- C. There will be only one division, Jib & Main, unless there are at least 3 boats registered to sail spinnaker before the 11 July 2026 deadline and there are at least 5 boats registered to sail Jib & Main.

II. Eligibility

- A. The helmsperson shall be the owner of a San Juan 21 except if the boat is owned by CSA then the helmsperson shall be an eligible member of CSA.
- B. The persons aboard shall be the same throughout the regattas except if a change in persons is approved by the PRO prior to the race where the persons are changed.

III. Registration

- A. Online registration may be completed at <https://csa-sailing.org/regattas> no later than 11 July 2026. Registrations after 11 July will be charged a \$5.00 late fee. On-site registration may be completed online or at CSA OB Registratiion Desk no later than 0900 on Saturday morning 18 July 2026.
- B. Check-in at the on-site registration desk is required, where Sailing Instructions will be provided.

IV. Fees

- A. The registration fee \$50 includes Dinner on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday for skipper and 1 crew.
- B. Extra dinner may be purchased for \$15 each and breakfast for \$10 each.

V. Schedule

- A. No maximum numbers of races are planned. One race will constitute the regatta.
- B. Saturday, 0930 Skipper's Meeting at the seawall by the RC boat, 1000 Harbor Warning, 1030 First Warning of the day. Additional races to follow.
- C. Sunday, 0800 breakfast in the OB, racing will be with the regular club races for the day, the PRO will announce our start. Awards after racing in the OB.

VI. Venue

- A. The race area will be on a course general east of the CSA harbor mouth.

VII. Courses

- A. The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward and further described in the Sis.

VIII. Penalties

- A. Where rule 44.1 calls for a 2 turn penalty, it is changed to a 1 turn penalty.

IX. Scoring

- A. Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores with no scores excluded.

X. Prizes

- A. Prizes will be awarded for the 1st three places (in each division if there are two)

XI. Radio Communication

- A. The race committee may use VHF radios to communicate with competitors while racing.

XII. Disclaimer of Liability

- A. Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk, *see RRS 3 Decision to Race*. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability to material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta and all other events associated with it.
