NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the *Wasp Class Rules* except as they are changed by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats who are members of the Waszp Class.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration form and fee payment found on the registration website.

3. FEES

The entry fee is \$100.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Friday, May 21

- 1400 Practice race
- 1800 "Galley Night" dinner at TRYC

Saturday, May 22

- 0830-0930 Registration
- 0930 Competitors Meeting
- 1100 First Warning
- 1500 Drinks and Hors d'oeuvres immediately following sailing

Sunday, May 23

- 1030 First Warning
- No warning signal will be made after 1430

- 4.2. Number of races: We will sail as many races as possible. The number of races per day will be determined by the Race Committee.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing instructions will be available at check-in and can be found on the registration website.

6. VENUE

The Racing area will be in the Toms River or on the Wannamaker course.

7. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. One race shall be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.2. (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (b) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats will be on the water to help all sailors.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1. Overall: 1st – 3rd
- 11.2. Special prizes may also be awarded.

12. SAFETY

- 12.1. Personal Floatation Devices shall be worn at all times while afloat, except for during brief times when a sailor is adding or removing clothing.
- 12.2. Helmets, while not required, are encouraged.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors Participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$500,000 per incident or the equivalent.

15. HOUSING

We will make every attempt to house sailors from out of town. Sailors should reach out to the regatta organizers if they would like housing. First come, first serve.
