Notice of Race

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing. World Sailing Development Rules for foiling classes and other class rules will apply as appropriate.

CLASSES: Foiling class vessels with at least five entries.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to small, wind-powered, foiling boats and boards. All competitors shall be members of US Sailing or a US Sailing affiliated club or organization.

VENUE: Races will be conducted near Cabrillo Beach, north of the Los Angeles Breakwater and east of the beach. Races will be conducted around a cross-shaped ('+') course, having an up-wind start to a weather mark, reaching legs, and a cross-wind or down-wind finish.

FLEETS: Foil Fest races will be conducted on the same venue, concurrent with the the WASZP Class PCC regatta. WASZP class will start first.

SCHEDULE: Five races are scheduled and three (3) will make a series. First warning is scheduled at 1330, and a three-minute starting sequence will be used. No race will be started after 1730 hrs.

SCORING: In accordance with RRS 90.3, except there will be no exclusions (Changing RRS Rule A2.1).

COMPETITORS MEETING: A sailors meeting will be held Saturday, 22 August, 1100hrs, near the Cabrillo Beach Bath House portico/patio.

LAUNCHING: Competitors may launch at Cabrillo Beach's designated board launching zone, or at the CBYC Dry Storage dinghy ramp.

IDENTIFICATION: Hard-shell foiling boats will be identified by their sail number. Board competitors shall wear a bib provided by the organizing authority with their assigned competitor identification number. (Changing RRS Appendix G and F9 G1(a)).

COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing instruction will be available online before 19 August 2026, and at Competitors meeting.

ENTRIES & FEES: Entries are online with Clubspot at the following website: <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/yBG7CfdH3r/>. All entries must be filed prior to race day. Entry fee is \$35.

PRIZES: Trophies will be awarded at the CBYC Clubhouse after the regatta, based on the number of entries.

ACTIVITIES: Competitors and guests are welcome to use CBYC facilities during the event. Bar food will be available after racing in CBYC dining room.
