1. RULES

- 1.1. This event will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. The entered skipper and crew shall sail the entire regatta together unless Section 8.6 below applies.
- 1.3. The Lido 14 Class Association By-Laws and Class Championship rules are available at [By-Laws, Tips, Tuning](#).
- 1.4. RRS 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: “(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident, or”
- 1.5. The US Sailing prescriptions are available: www.ussailing.org/competition/rules-officiating/racing-rules.
- 1.6. Appendix T (Arbitration and Post Race Penalties) applies.
- 1.7. US Forest rules require and RRS 40.1 is in effect: All competitors must wear USCG approved personal flotation devices while racing. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at Check-In and on the Official Notice Board.

3. COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. This will be the most up-to-date regatta information

- 3.2. All competitors are strongly encouraged to carry VHF radio.
- 3.3. VHF radio may be used by the race committee to communicate with competitors on the water.
Additional instructions regarding radio communication will be included in the SI's.
- 3.4. The Official Notice board is located at the launch ramp beach.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. This regatta is open to all boats of the Lido 14 class that comply with the Lido 14 Class Association By-Laws.
- 4.2. To enter, visit the event webpage on www.lido14class.com. Complete the online entry process in Clubspot.
- 4.3. Late Entries will be accepted until 11:59 a.m. PST Monday, July 13, 2026.
- 4.4. Entrants will be approved to race after:
 - 4.4.1 The online entry has been completed, including payment of the entry fee.
 - 4.4.2 The Liability Release and Parental Consent forms for competitors under the age of eighteen (18) years have been completed and accepted. The forms will be available on the event webpage. Waivers e-signed with Yes, during registration are acceptable.

- 4.4.3 The entered skipper's membership of the Lido 14 Class Association is verified. See NOR 8.
- 4.4.4 The skipper and crew have presented themselves, any required boat and crew ballast weight, and their Lido 14 Class Association Official Certificate of Measurement at Check-In. It is requested that all items be presented at one time. See also "Inspection" and "Further Information" below.

5. FEES AND CANCELLATIONS

- 5.1. The entry fee is \$140 if received by June 7, 2026.
- 5.2. The entry fee is \$200 if received by July 5, 2026.
- 5.3. The entry fee is \$250 if received by July 13, 2026.
- 5.4. No Entries or fees will be accepted after 12:00 pm. July 13, 2026.
- 5.5. Entrants will receive a full refund if canceled before June 21, 2026. No Shows or cancellations after June 21, 2026 may not receive a refund.
- 5.6. Crews shall receive two t-shirts, and two tickets for Wednesday dinner at the Shoreline Lodge.
- 5.7. Extra t-shirts and dinner tickets may be purchased on Clubspot.

6. QUALIFYING SERIES AND CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES

- 6.1. This event consists of a qualifying series and a championship series.
- 6.2. The qualifying series is scheduled to be a round-robin of flights that are seeded by the Lido Association.
- 6.3. The Championship Series will consist of Gold and Silver fleets.
- 6.4. Boats will be assigned to the Gold and Silver fleets per the Lido 14 Class Association Bylaw Article XV, which assigns boats based on their performance in the Qualifying Series.
- 6.5. Boats not sailing the qualifying series will be placed in the Silver fleet and are not eligible to receive a trophy in the Championship Series.
- 6.6. Decisions by the protest committee for incidents involving the qualifying series may not be appealed. In accordance with rule 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US Sailing's permission has been granted. US Sailing's permission is limited to the Qualifying Series. A copy of US Sailing's permission will be posted on the official notice board.

7. SCHEDULE

- 7.1. Three (3) races are scheduled for each flight of the qualifying series.
- 7.2. Eight (8) races are scheduled for each of the Gold and Silver fleets.
- 7.3. No race will be started after 3:30 p.m. on Thursday July 17, 2026.

8. ON-SITE REGISTRATION, WEIGH-IN AND INSPECTIONS

- 8.1. The Race Committee may inspect any equipment from the time a boat finishes a race until the close of the day's posted protest filing period.
- 8.2. Verifying the skipper's membership in the Lido14 Class Association is in good standing.
- 8.3. Providing the Official Certificate of Measurement with any ballast weight.
 - 8.3.1. A boat with ballast that is not removable shall bring it to the attention at Check-In to arrange for an inspection of the weight by the Class Measure or Association Officer.
- 8.4. Verifying the online entry has been completed, including payment of entry fees and signing the regatta waivers.
- 8.5. Skipper and crew shall be present in normal sailing attire when presenting themselves to be weighed at Check-In. Underweight crews shall present their own ballast weight.
- 8.6. Requests for substitute crew or equipment shall be limited to emergency circumstances and shall be made to the Race Committee, who has the sole authority to issue an "OK to Race" for substitutions.

- 9.2. Check-In & Registration will be in Huntington Lake Boat Ramp Beach.

10. Penalty System

11. SCORING

- 11.1 The qualifying series, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. No scores from the qualifying series will carry over to the championship series.
- 11.2 Three (3) races of the Qualifying Series must be scored to constitute the qualifying series.
- 11.3 Two (2) races of the Gold fleet shall be completed to constitute a series. If fewer than three (3) races are scored no race scores shall be excluded.
- 11.4 Two (2) races of the silver fleet shall be completed to constitute a series. If fewer than three (3) races are scored no race scores shall be excluded.

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13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 13.1. Competitors participate in the regatta, entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 34, Decision to Race. Neither FYCC nor the Lido14 Association, volunteers or officials will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
- 13.2. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with minimum coverage of US \$300,000.00 per event or the equivalent.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1. Prizes will be awarded to both skipper and crew for:
 - 14.1.1 Top five (5) boats of the Gold fleet.
 - 14.1.2 Top five (5) boats of the Silver fleet.
 - 14.1.3 Lido 14 Class Association Perpetual Trophies.
