Dooley Roosevelt Memorial Regatta One Day Pursuit Race

NOTICE OF RACE

Saturday, August 1, 2026

1. RULES AND ADVERTISING

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the current PHRF Regulations, as administered by the YRA of Long Island Sound (YRALIS) and the United States Sailing Safety Equipment Recommendations, with this event classified as a “Nearshore” event.
- 1.2. Racing Rule 26.1 is changed to a “Pursuit Start”. A “Pursuit Start” is where the handicap time is applied at the Start. The slowest rated boat starts first and each following boat starts at a set time afterwards based on their rating.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Eligible competitors shall be yachts who have a current YRALIS PHRF Certificate, completed an entry form, and paid the entry fee prior to 1200 on Friday, July 31, 2026. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Race Committee. Yachts without valid PHRF certificates may enter but will be subject to a five second penalty on their last known rating.

3. FEES

The entry fee will be \$35 per yacht.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. There will be skippers' meeting held at or near the Linburn Terrace of the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club at 1030 hours on Saturday, August 1, 2026.
- 4.2. There will be one race.
- 4.3. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1255 for the slowest rated (scratch) boat.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions and a scratch sheet will be available in print at the competitors meeting on the day of the race. Documents will also be available at https://www.seawanhaka.org/On_The_Water/Regattas_Results.

6. VENUE

The racing area will be in the vicinity of Oyster Bay, Cold Spring Harbor and Long Island Sound.

7. COURSES

Courses will be sailed around fixed marks in Long Island Sound, Cold Spring Harbor and Oyster Bay. The marks and the sequence of rounding shall be listed in the Sailing Instructions. Charts of the marks used and standard courses are available on the club's regattas webpage.

8. SCORING

Each Division will be scored separately.

9. BERTHING

Competitors may arrange for a complementary mooring by calling the club at 516-922-6200 or the SCYC Launch on Channel 10.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

All yachts must have a working VHF Radio.

11. PRIZES

11.1 In the event of a tie the Race Committee will determine the winner at its discretion.

11.2 All Prizes will be presented at the Seawanhaka Annual Awards Dinner on Saturday, October 24, 2026
All Competitors are invited.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3; Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

Each participating yacht shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.
