Registration via the ILYA is online through Clubspot-please register before arrival. All food must be ordered **by July 29<sup>th</sup>**. Merchandise will be available onsite from The Boaters Closet on Tues Aug 13-Thursday Aug 15<sup>th</sup> at the CLYC.

Launching and check in will be at the CLYC. Sunday Aug 11 A's 10 am-4 pm . MC's 10 am-8 pm.  
Wed Aug 14<sup>th</sup> E/C 10 am-8 pm

There will be no registration/check-in available Monday Aug 12<sup>th</sup> for the MC's nor Thursday Aug 15<sup>th</sup> for the E/C's.

**Due to a community event downtown and around the regatta site-all boats arriving on Saturday Aug 10th must park at their hotel or in the parking lot of Kingland Systems-1402 6th Ave South.**

**Arrival and Launching:**

**A's**-Exit I-35 #193 on to 4<sup>th</sup> Ave South- to South Shore Drive-Right to barricades for direction. A's will be using their own tow vehicle to launch and haul out their boats. A's proceed to parking space and rig. One vehicle may stay.

**MC, E, C** -Please Exit I-35 #194 and head west on Hwy18/122—South on N 8<sup>th</sup> Street---right onto 1<sup>st</sup> Ave North to bring you into the loop on the north side of City Park—there will be

signage-and you will be greeted as you reach the barricades at the park. Google has you take the second exit to the south into Clear Lake which is not direct to the launch.

**E/C** arrival as directed from the barricades-as we have extra launch space on **Wed the 14<sup>th</sup>**.

For racing-- MC, E and C's will be launched and hauled out using ATV's. Proceed to chosen parking space and rig- vehicle moved out asap.

At registration, all boats except A's will have their boats and trailers labeled/numbered for trailer retrieval-even if wet sailing.

### **Measurement and weight**

An inspection of lead and silver weight sticker will be required prior to check in.

### **Check in process**

Once the boat is assigned a number, set up, and inspected, proceed to the CLYC and head up the stairs to the loft area.

Please bring any perpetual trophies cleaned/polished and in their boxes to The Lakeview Room-bandshell area.

Complete regatta registration with the ILYA and the CLYC

1. Pick up goodie bags and information packet
2. Purchase meal/social packages-**quantities will be limited or unavailable.**
3. Sign up for spectator boats

### **Trailer Parking**

Follow signs to trailer parking -across from Kingland Systems 1401 6<sup>th</sup> Ave South. Signs will provide guidance into parking lot-- please keep to the North and West corner (to the Left as you drive in).

### **Mooring**

In front of the CLYC and 3 blocks around to the South- Mooring must be within the 300 ft marker. Sand bottom approx. 10ft deep. If dry sailing must bring a mooring for lunches.

### **Tender Vessels**

May launch each morning at the CLYC-enter on 1<sup>st</sup> Ave N through launching area and out by the CLYC—**must be 90 minutes before scheduled warning or before.** Trailers to Kingland-1401 6<sup>th</sup> Ave South. Haul out only after all sailboats out of the water. Map at registration of other launching areas.

Spectator/tender boat parking is at City Dock during the day only. No overnight tie up is allowed per city ordinance. Please plan on arranging private docking or taking your power boat out each evening.

### **Docking**

The CLYC dock will be used exclusively for Race Committee docking and transporting sailors to the mooring field.

The City Dock will be used for spectator pick up and Emergency response. Power boats can be parked there but not overnight.

### **Parking**

Vehicle parking will be available daily on the surrounding streets around the CLYC and city lots located near the CLYC.

### **Slow NO WAKE Zones**

Boats cannot exceed five MPH within one 100 feet of another boat going five MPH or less. Boats must maintain a distance of 50 feet from each other when both boats are traveling at speeds greater than five MPH. **Slow No Wake Zones within 300 ft of shore (Iowa Law).**

### **Bathroom Facilities at the CLYC**

There are Ladies and Men's bathrooms at the CLYC. Porta Potties will also be placed on the CLYC grounds. In addition, bathrooms are available at the splash pad and at the bandshell in the park.

### **Regatta Notice Board**

An unofficial notice board will be displayed on the outside of the CLYC building on the lakeside.

### **Protest Forms**

Protest forms will be available in the kitchen at the CLYC. All protests will be heard in The Lakeview Room-directly across from the CLYC on lakeside of the bandshell.

### **Spectator Boats**

Spectator boats for both fleets will be available at City dock for pick up. Sign up during the check in process. Contact is Mike Starbeck-319-290-9088

### **Take Out and In on Wednesday**

On Wed-- finish and haul out as usual. There will be extra derigging space allowed as to make room for the E/C's.

Lakeside guests can leave your boats on trailers there and return to the CLYC for lunch and Awards.

E/C's will be directed at barricades to North Lakeview Drive-parked 2 wide until A/MC's have departed.

**Alcohol Policy** No alcohol will be sold on the CLYC grounds. Coolers with beverages are permitted.
