Visitor's access to RCYC

Visitors can access the RCYC Island via the RCYC launch service that departs from 150 Cherry St., or via water taxi services. Paid parking is available at 150 Cherry St., and there is also limited free street parking.

Once on the Island, you may access many of the Club's amenities including:

- Dining facilities
- Complimentary bicycle, canoe, kayak and stand-up paddle board rentals
- Gate access to the Toronto Islands
- Outdoor pool

All amenities may be accessed with a visitor's card of which can be signed out at the RCYC Sailing Office.

Please let us know in advance if you plan to come to the Island so that we can have your visitor's card ready for pick up at the sailing office on the Island. As your athlete gets ready for sailing Saturday and Sunday mornings, you may also stop by the coffee table for additional information.

Please note that the Cherry St. Bridge may still be closed so plan your trip accordingly as you will need to access the Club via Unwin Avenue.
