NOTICE OF RACE

1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Beach Point Yacht Club (Host) in partnership with the Junior Sailing Association of Long Island Sound (JSA).

2 RULES

The regatta is governed by:

- a. the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- b. the Rules for JSA Events
- c. the JSA Code of Conduct
- d. US Sailing [SafeSport Handbook](#)

3 COMMUNICATION

1. Coaches and support boats must monitor the race committee VHF channel and follow any safety instructions issued by the race committee. Instructors may communicate and listen via channel 80A.

4 ELIGIBILITY

- a. This regatta is open to all competitors of the Optimist class who meet JSA and regatta eligibility requirements.
- b. If either the JSA weight or age requirement for the boat class is not met, the sailor shall file the JSA underage/underweight permission request form as directed in the JSA Online Regatta Registration system. This permission request is subject to acceptance by the Regatta Chair.

5 REGISTRATION and ENTRY FEES

- a. Register online at www.theclubspot.com.
- b. The entry fee is \$45.00 per sailor due at 1700 on July 31st, 2026. The fee for entries submitted after the due date is \$50.00 per sailor. Entries will be accepted on the day of the event with a fee of \$60.00 per sailor. There is no fee to send an Instructor.
- c. All skippers and Instructors shall appear in person at the registration table during the registration period or check in on the water.
- d. Instructors shall attend the instructors' meeting to receive safety assignments.

- f. We invite sailors to join us on land after the event for lunch and refreshments.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8 SUPPORT VESSELS

- a. Any program entering three or more boats shall supply an instructor with a support vessel equipped with a working VHF radio, an anchor and a first aid kit.
- b. All support vessels shall be equipped with a functioning engine safety cut-out switch (kill switch) which shall remain attached to the operator at all times while the engine is running.
- c. The instructor shall register with the OA at registration to receive safety patrol assignments.
- d. Any program entering fewer than three boats that will not supply a support vessel shall arrange with another program to allow the supervising Instructor out onto the water. In no circumstance shall competitors be allowed to sail without a designated instructor on the race course.

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the race committee.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY & RISK STATEMENT

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The OA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
