Commodore's Message

- Commodore highlighted SDAYC's strong showing at the **2025 Transpac Race**:
 - SDYC Vice Commodore Alli Bell: First female skipper to win Transpac and took 1st overall on corrected time.
 - o **Tom Holthus (SDYC)**: Won **Division 1** with his boat *BadPak*.



Evening Program: Port Developments & Community Engagement

Guest Speaker: Danielle Moore, Chair of the Port of San Diego Board of Commissioners

Key points covered:

- **Big Bay Boom Fireworks**: Over \$100M economic impact, half a million attendees. Environmental mitigation efforts including water testing, debris cleanup, and feasibility study for drone/hybrid displays.
- **Gaylord Pacific Resort & Convention Center**: 22 stories, 1,600 rooms, \$265M public contribution; opened on time and budget.
- **TopGolf Project**: Proposed for Harbor Island; under environmental review.
- **Harbor Island West Marina**: \$67M redevelopment project to begin summer 2025, 2-year timeline.
- **Fisherman's Landing & Driscoll's Wharf**: Significant investment in sport and commercial fishing infrastructure.
- **Coronado YC Redevelopment**: \$18M investment, new public access, promenade, and clubhouse; environmental review phase.
- **National City Balance Plan**: Park expansion, terminal efficiency improvements, and hotel/RV developments.
- Maritime Clean Air Strategy: Electrification of port infrastructure, including cranes and tugboats. No tax revenue—entirely funded by leases and maritime activity.

- Details on Seaport Village, National City development, and port funding mechanisms
- Comments on fireworks regulation and community access
