NOTICE OF RACE



The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Coronado Yacht Club (CorYC)

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and INSA Class Rules.
- 1.2 Breaches of instructions which are annotated [NP] will not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This changes rule 60.2. If the jury concludes that a boat has broken one of these rules, or rule 47, it may impose a penalty other than disqualification. In these cases, the discretionary penalty, if less than disqualification, will be represented by the scoring abbreviation "DPI". The penalty imposed by the jury in such a case constitutes the "other penalty" in the first sentence of rule 64.2.
- 1.3 [NP] Competitors shall wear USCG-approved PFDs at all times while on the water, other than during brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The race committee will not fly the 'Y' flag. This modifies RRS 40.1, 40.2 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.4 The US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 63.1 will not apply.
- 1.5 Other changes to rules may appear in the relevant Sailing Instructions (SI).
- 1.6 Where there is a conflict between the rules in the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail. This changes RRS 65.3(c).

2. Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1 All boats must be Naples Sabots.
- 2.2 Competitors must have placed in the top 10 at the Sabot II North and South Regattas to be eligible for the Championship.
- 2.3 All online entries must be submitted by Wednesday, July 15, at 5:00 p.m. To register online please visit the [Regatta Homepage](#).
- 2.4 Entry fee is \$25.

4. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be posted no later than check-in on July 16, 2026.

5. Racing Venue and Courses

- 5.1 Boat Launching: Coach Boats can be launched at Coronado Yacht Club.
- 5.2 Racing will take place in Glorietta Bay.
- 5.3 The course may be a windward–leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the sailing instructions.

6. Weights

- 6.1 Skipper weights are not required for a Sabot II Championship event.

7. Format & Scoring

- 7.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. After five races, there will be one throwout of each competitor's worst race.
