1 Rules

- 1.1 The event series is governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 RRS A5.3 applies.

2 Disclaimer

- 2.1 Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS Rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, the sponsors, the race committee, officers and board of directors of Santa Cruz Yacht Club, and all those involved in these organizations will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after this regatta.

3 Sailing Instructions

- 3.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at 2100 hours on or before August 12, 2026, at <https://scyc.org/regatta/Bh8EYGw6Zq>

4 Communication

- 4.1 The online official notice board is located in the event listing at the above website.
- 4.2 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 4.3 Ashore, notices shall be posted in the Race Office North window.

5 Eligibility and Entry

- 5.1 The event is open to all boats of the Santana 22, Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 classes.
- 5.2 Other one-design classes with at least three entries may petition to participate prior to 1000 hours on August 12, 2026.
- 5.3 Boats may enter this event only by registering online at event listing at the above website.

6 Fees

- 6.1 The entry fee is \$150 for regular members and \$100 for Corinthians if entry is completed by 2100 hours on August 12, 2026.
- 6.2 The Late entry fee of \$170 is applied to all entries received after 2100 hours on Wednesday, August 12, 2026.
- 6.3 One-Day entries are permitted. The entry fee is \$70. One-Day entries must be registered by 0800 hours the day prior to the day of racing.
- 6.4 Registration for the Series closes at 0800 hours on October 16th.

7 Schedules

- 7.1 A competitor's briefing is scheduled for 1100 hours on Saturday, August 15, 2026, at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club Clubhouse.
- 7.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 7.3 For each class nine (9) races are scheduled for the series with three (3) races each day.
- 7.4 The Race Committee may change the number of races held each day at its discretion.
- 7.5 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse each day following racing.

8 Venue

- 8.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed marks within a three-mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.
- 8.2 A course diagram will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

9 Prizes

- 9.1 Prizes will be given as follows: A daily first place prize will be awarded for each division and Series prizes will be awarded at the end of the Series based on the number of entries in each division.
- 9.2 A regatta winning SCYC boat and owner/skipper in any division with three (3) or more entries with a current PHRF rating will be eligible to compete in the Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions Regatta.
