1. Organizing Authority

2. Rules

- 2.1 This regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Prescriptions of U.S. Sailing GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events will govern Capdevielle competition. Class Rules and GYA PHRF bylaws apply to their respective classes. The Mardi Gras Regatta Sailing Instructions and This Notice of Regatta (NOR). The Sailing instructions shall govern in the event of conflict where applicable. Sailing instructions will be available at the skipper's meeting.
- 2.2 The U S Sailing Prescriptions to RSS 63.1 and RRS 63,2 are deleted.
- 2.3 Only Capdevielle competitors may change Crews and Helmsmen between races.

4. Registration

Registration may be completed during any registration period (See below for registration deadlines) prior to the boat's Skipper's Meeting. You may register online at [Event Page \(https://theclubspot.com/regatta/nnm35m2k2m\)](https://theclubspot.com/regatta/nnm35m2k2m) or in person.

The Regatta Committee requests that skippers register early so that trophies and merchandise items may be ordered and engraved in advance of the regatta.

5. Entry Fee

The entry fee (US Funds) may be paid by credit card, cash, or club cross charge for members of clubs with reciprocal privileges. Refunds are available before February 1.

Pay one entry fee of \$55 and race two weekends.

U.S. Sailing Members may deduct \$5 from the entry fee.

6. Schedule of Events

An updated schedule will be release as the race date approaches.

All events are held at NOYC unless otherwise noted.

A separate social event schedule will be released later.

7. Number of Races

GYA Capdevielle – Five races will be scheduled in accordance with the Optional Alternative Format as described for Sanctioned Events.

For all other classes – The Race Committee, at its discretion, will attempt to run as many races as possible on each race day, unless otherwise noted.

8. Scoring

For all classes – The RRS Low Point System (RRS A4) shall be used. No scored will be excluded. One race constitutes a series. This changes RRS A2.

9. Skipper's Meeting

The Skipper's Meetings will be held at New Orleans Yacht Club in the bar area at which time Sailing Instructions will be distributed. It is mandatory for a representative of each boat to attend.

10. Decision to Race and Liability

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the Regatta.

11. Advertising

Entrants are required to carry event advertising as outlined in ISAF Regulation 20.4 or will not be scored.

12. Racing Area

The racing area will be located on the south shore of Lake Pontchartrain.

13. Official Notice Board

The Notice Board is located just inside the north harbor entrance on NOYC.
