NOTICE OF RACE



The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Coronado Yacht Club (CoRYC)

1. Rules

- 1.1. This event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and by the Club FJ Class Association Rules.
 - 1.1.2 CFJ Class Rules Paragraph 35 Crew Weight will be in effect, see NOR paragraph 6.
- 1.2. A condition of entry and participation in this event is the wearing of a U.S. Coast Guard-approved lifejacket or, for international sailors only, a lifejacket approved by their country's corresponding authority, properly secured at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing. All life jackets must be suitable for the competitor's weight. Wet suits, dry suits, and inflatable life jackets do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy. These changes are added to RRS 40, and the Preamble to Part 4 will not apply to RRS 40.
- 1.3. In the event of a conflict, the SIs shall prevail over this NOR, except in matters governed by RRS rules 63.7 and 87.

2. Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1. This event is open to teams meeting the following eligibility requirements:
 - 2.1.1. Teams shall sail in a fully measured boat of the CFJ Class.
 - 2.1.2. Teams shall consist of two (2) people.
 - 2.1.3. Both Skipper and crew must be members, in good standing, of the CFJ Class Association ([Class Website](#)). Membership will be verified at the time of online registration and during regatta check-in.
 - 2.1.4. Members of a team shall not have reached nineteen (19) years of age by the closing of the event.
 - 2.1.5. Members of a team shall not have attended college (unless while still in High School).
- 2.2. Eligible teams may enter their boat by completing online registration at the [CFJ Nationals webpage](#) and paying all fees by Wednesday, July 15. Entries submitted after that time will be charged a \$50 late fee.
- 2.3. The entry deadline for all competitors is Thursday, July 23 at 1600.
- 2.4. Only entries that have completed Check-in by 1700 on Thursday, July 23, will be eligible to race. Late Check-in may be allowed only with the approval of the Event Chair, and arrangements must be made before 1600 on Thursday, July 23.

All times are local Pacific Time. The schedule is subject to change; any changes will be posted on the official notice board.

5. Measurement

- 5.1. All entries must submit a completed and signed CFJ Nationals Equipment Inspection Form to the Registration Desk during the Check-in period to be eligible to race. This form will be available at Check-in.
- 5.2. Equipment check, hull and sail measurement for all entries will take place during the Check-in period.
 - 5.2.1 All boats will be weighed.
 - 5.2.2 Sails will be inspected and, if not previously measured, will be measured.
 - 5.2.3. All equipment will be inspected for class compliance.
- 5.3. Boats that fail measurement will be given an opportunity to correct deficiencies before racing. A boat that has not passed measurement may not race.
- 5.4. **New boats, older boats not previously measured by the class, and boats without a valid measurement certificate on file with the Class must arrange for a measurement appointment with the class secretary.** This measurement will take place from 1000-1200 on Thursday, July 23.
- 5.5. Contact Rachel Dewey, CFJ Class Secretary, by 5 pm on Tuesday, July 14 at Info@scyyra.org to make a measurement appointment.

6. Crew Weight

- 6.1. CFJ Class Rules specify that the minimum crew weight must be two hundred forty (240) pounds; however, no crew shall be required to carry more than twenty-five (25) pounds of corrector weight. Crews carrying the maximum amount of corrector weight are excused from the two-hundred-forty (240) pound minimum weight requirement.
- 6.2. Each competitor shall be weighed dry, wearing a T-shirt and shorts during regatta check-in.
- 6.3. Teams shall present themselves and their team's corrector weights (if any) to the Registration Desk for weighing during the Check-in period.

7. Racing Area

Racing will be held on South San Diego Bay. A chart showing the approximate racing area will be included with the Sailing Instructions.

8. Courses

Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the [CFJ Nationals webpage](#) by Wednesday, July 22, 2026. Course Charts will be available at the Registration Desk.

10. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply. Three races must be completed to constitute a series.

11. Communication

- 11.1 The official notice board will be located on the website
- 11.2 On site notice board will be located outside of the Junior Office at Coronado Yacht Club.
- 11.3 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and other electronic communication devices.

12. Support Boats & Coaches

Support boats and coach boats must register online and check in before the first day of racing and display the identifying flag or sticker issued at check-in. Support boats shall remain outside the course area during racing and shall comply with all instructions from the Race Committee and on-water patrol.

13. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers, skipper, and crew on Sunday. The top finishing team will have their names engraved on the Warmington CFJ National Championship Trophy

14. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
