We are excited to welcome you to our club located on Geist Reservoir! The organizing authority for this regatta is the Indianapolis Sailing Club (ISC) and USSCA Sunfish Fleet #753.

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules – The regatta shall be governed by the current version of the *US Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the Sunfish Sailing Association Class rules except as modified in this Notice of Race (NOR), and /or the Sailing Instructions (SI). RRS Appendix A5.3 and V2 apply. All participants shall comply with Indiana law including but not limited to the Indiana DNR Safety Rules. This includes carrying Indiana State required safety equipment such as a wearable PFD. See <https://www.boat-ed.com/indiana/handbook/>.

2. Eligibility

2.1 The regatta is open to all competitors sailing a boat of the Sunfish Class. Competitors shall complete registration with the Indianapolis Sailing Club.

2.2 Skippers are responsible for their sailboats complying with all Sunfish Class measurement rules. To be accounted for in the scoring, all sailboats shall have at least two numbers on the sail. Sailboats are subject to random inspections.

3. Entry Fee & Registration – **Registration for a skipper by June 12** includes a commemorative shirt received at the regatta and 3 meals on Saturday and 2 meals on Sunday **for \$65. Registration for a skipper by June 24** includes all meals and shirt to be delivered* after the regatta **for \$65. If register June 25-27, cost is \$80** and includes only the shirt to be delivered*; we will do our best, but meals cannot be guaranteed for these registrations. **All skippers and guests must register by Wednesday June 24 to be included in food count.** Guest meals, if needed, are \$20 for the Saturday dinner and \$10 for all other meals (\$50 for meal package). *Due to print deadlines, shirts for registrations after June 12 will not be available at the regatta; must make arrangements by end of season to meet at future regattas or pay for shipping.

4. Official Notices to Competitors – Official Notices to competitors shall be posted on the Official Notice Board (ONB) on the wall of the ISC Clubhouse by the front door. The Protest Notice Board shall be a part of the Official Notice Board.

5. Regatta Meals – Limited by Section 3 above, Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner shall be provided on Saturday, and Breakfast and Lunch shall be provided on Sunday. It is intended that Friday Dinner is an optional “chip in” group pizza order; sailors to coordinate with a Regatta Co-Chair by 5:00 PM that Friday. Some iced single use bottled water will be available; in support of minimizing plastic waste, we encourage sailors to carry their own water supplies.

8. Venue & Lodging

8.1 The Indianapolis Sailing Club is located at 11325 Fall Creek Road, Indianapolis, Indiana 46256 (corner of Brooks School Road). The ISC sails upon beautiful Geist Reservoir, 1890 acres of great Midwestern flatwater. The reservoir is located in the far northeast of the greater Indianapolis metro. Wi-Fi internet in the Clubhouse is available for use.

8.2 Camping is available on the ISC grounds with showers in the ISC Clubhouse. If the weather becomes over wet, bedrolls may be taken into the ISC Clubhouse. RVs may be parked in the ISC parking lot without external electricity.

9. Scoring – Scoring shall be in accordance with Appendix A of RRS. All race scores shall be counted. RRS Appendix A5.3 applies.

10. Course – The race course shall be sailed around drop marks on the lake. It is intended that the course shall be a modified Windward Leeward course (WA#), RRS Appx S, with the winning Sunfish completing the race course in 25 to 45 minutes. The race course shall be discussed at the Competitor's Meeting.

11. Prizes – Prizes shall be awarded to the top skippers in the Regatta.

12. INSURANCE, SAFETY & DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Each participating boat is encouraged to be insured with adequate liability insurance.

12.2 Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3 Decision to Race (“The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.”). By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

12.3 Competitors agree that the race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. As an inducement to the race organizers to produce the race, each competitor agrees that by participating in this event each competitor is deemed to have waived all claims against and released the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor’s participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law. Each competitor is solely responsible for his own safety and agrees to sail and utilize ISC’s facilities at his/her own risk.

13. Precedence – In the event of a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions have precedence.
