1. RULES:

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. Participants agree to abide by the RRS and all other rules that govern this event and those of the host club. Payment of the Entry Fee acknowledges agreement and consent to the rule requirement of this NOR.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. The helmsperson shall be a current Individual, Life, Junior, Club or Family Member of the FSSA.
- 2.2. The total number of persons aboard a boat shall be two (2), three (3) or four (4). The same crew (number and persons) shall be carried throughout all races of the event.

3. REGISTRATION:

- 3.1. Online registration may be completed at ([Registration](#)). Late and/or on-site registration may be completed online or at the HSC Clubhouse Registration Desk no later than 1130 on August 15, 2026. (Please note that meals for late registrants may be subject to availability.)
- 3.2. Check-in at the on-site registration desk is required, where Sailing Instructions (SI) will be provided.

4. FEES:

- 4.1. The registration fee (\$85) includes entry fee, Continental breakfasts and lunches Sunday, snacks and beverages after racing Saturday, and dinner Saturday evening.
- 4.2. For extra meals for the weekend see the Registration form.

5. SCHEDULE:

- 5.1. Six races are planned.
- 5.2. The Regatta Schedule below provides a list of events, dates and times that are planned for the regatta.

6. MEASUREMENT:

- 6.1. Boats and sails must conform to the Specifications in the Class Rules.
- 6.2. All sail numbers shall match the hull number except for chartered boats, and club boats must be identified as proscribed in Class Rule, Article B-IX.

6.3. Each boat must carry safety equipment required by the FSSA and the US Coast Guard which includes having an inflated bow bag and transom port.

7. VENUE:

7.1. The race area will be on Hoover Reservoir.

8. THE COURSES:

8.1. The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions. At a minimum, windward-leeward courses will be included.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM:

9.1. US Sailing Prescription Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, Rules V1 and V2 will be in effect.

10. SCORING:

10.1. One completed race will constitute a series.

10.2. Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores, and no score shall be excluded.

11. PRIZES:

11.1. Trophies will be awarded as follows:

11.1.1. 1st through 3rd place

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION:

12.1. The race committee may use VHF radios to communicate with competitors while racing. See Class Rules, Article S-V - Racing Restrictions, Paragraph 7 for more information regarding electronic equipment.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

13.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 3 Decision to Race). The Organizing Authorities will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta and all events associated with it.
