NOTICE OF RACE (NoR)

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and US Sailing Prescriptions except as modified herein and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is North Cove Yacht Club.
- 1.2. The North Cove Yacht Club strongly recommends that entrants comply with the US Safety Equipment Requirements for Nearshore Races available at www.ussailing.org
- 1.3. Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: (2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the **Regatta Website**.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. Club Spot will be the on-line document repository and registration system (**Regatta Website**)
- 3.2. The online official notice board is located on the **Regatta Website**
- 3.3. All boats shall carry a VHF radio.
- 3.4. On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.5. While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. This regatta is open to Spinnaker class PHRF, Non-Spinnaker classes
- 4.2. Classes shall be defined as per a scratch sheet posted on the **Regatta Website** by 0800 hours September 13th 2026.
- 4.3. Eligible boats may enter the event by registering online on the **Regatta Website**.
- 4.4. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees by 1800 hours September 12th, 2026.
- 4.5. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the OA.
- 4.6. ECSA PHRF rating will be used to score this event. Any boats without a valid PHRF will be given the basic base rating for the make and model of their boat.

5. FEES

5.1. Entry fee for the event is \$25 per boat.

5.2. Fees are payable on the **Regatta Website** or in cash at North Cove Yacht Club.

6. SCHEDULE

6.1. First Warning is scheduled for 1200 hours Sunday September 13th 2026.

6.2. No warning signal will be made after 1500.

7. VENUE

Racing will take place in Long Island Sound just south of the Connecticut River

8. COURSES

8.1. The courses to be sailed will consist of government and dropped marks.

8.2. The courses will be posted on the Race Committee Signal boat as specified in the Sailing Instructions.

8.3. The marks will be identified in the Sailing Instructions

9. SCORING

Time on Time calculation using the ECSA / PHRF Time Correction Factor will be used to score PHRF Classes.

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishing skippers in each class at the post-race party at North Cove Yacht Club at the end of the day.
