Organizing Authority: South Beach Yacht Club, San Francisco CA.

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules:

- a. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- b. All competitors are required to wear personal flotation devices that are USCG or ISO approved. Belt Packs are not allowed. The "Y" flag will not be displayed.

2. Eligibility and Entry:

- a. The regatta is open to all keelboats with a valid 2026 Northern California PHRF certificate. The skipper and crew must be women.
- b. Boats without certificates will be assigned a PHRF rating at the sole and unappealable discretion of the Race Committee.
- c. Eligible boats must enter and pay online at <https://southbeachyachtclub.org/regatta/ZOdSFeOE9K>
- d. One design classes or established handicap classes with five (5) or more paid entries by September 22, 2026 will receive their own start and complete as their own class/division. Classes

conforming to this instruction after September 22, 2026 will be accommodated at the discretion of the OA.

3. Fees:

- a. Entry fees are: \$50 if received by September 21, 2026
- b. Entries received after September 21, midnight, are \$75.
- c. No entries will be accepted after September 24 at 1200 hours.

4. Schedule of Race:

- a. Racing will be held on September 26, 2025.
- b. A Competitors meeting will be held at 1030 hours in the SBYC Clubhouse, September 26, 2026.
- c. Weather permitting, three races will be sailed.
- d. The first warning is scheduled for 1230 hours.
- e. No race will be started after 1600 hours.

5. Racing Area and Courses:

- a. The race will be sailed in the South Bay waters of San Francisco Bay.
- b. Both fixed and temporary marks may be used.
- c. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

6. Sailing Instructions:

The Sailing Instructions will be available by 1800 hours on September 24, 2026 at <https://southbeachyachtclub.org/regatta/ZOdSFeOE9K/#notice-board>

7. Scoring:

Races will be scored time-on-time under PHRF, or one-design rules as appropriate and as further specified in the Sailing Instructions (SIs).

8. Prizes:

- a. Prizes will be awarded to first through third place finishers in each class with six or more boats.
- b. Prizes will be awarded to first and second place finishers in each class with less than six boats.
- c. The trophy presentation will be held at SBYC after racing.

9. DOCKAGE:

Guest berthing is available at the South Beach Marina. Contact the Harbor Office (415) 495-4911 and mention that you will be racing with the Red Bra Regatta.

10. PARKING:

Parking is available at the South Beach Marina Parking area. Contact the Harbor Office (415) 495-4911.

11. Disclaimer of Liability:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 3, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
