1. RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The International Laser Class rules apply with the exception of Non-ILCA class sails which may be used if they are built according to the ILCA handbook and are made of Dacron, mass produced and readily available.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES: The event is open to all ILCA4, ILCA6 and ILCA7's of the ILCA International Laser Class Association. Sailors shall wear a Type III PFD or other approved buoyancy aid at all times on the water. Competitors must be able to swim and to right a capsized boat and be able to climb into the righted boat from the water.

3. CLASSES: There will be two Classes scored for the regatta. The ILCA4's and ILCA6's together will make one Class and the ILCA7's will make the other Class. All ILCA classes will start together, however the Regatta Committee may ask the RC PRO to run a separate start for the of ILCA 4's and ILCA 6's if there are sufficient registered ILCA4's and ILCA6's to warrant a separate start.

5. REGISTRATION AND FEES: All registrations must be completed through the event website <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/kCuWTIX6h0> Entry fee for the regatta is \$50.00. *Before participating at this event, every competitor coach and/or support personnel shall sign a Waiver of Liability at check in.* Saturday's dinner, a traditional KYC Lobster fest, is not included in the regatta fee. Tickets for dinner are \$45 and will be available through the event website and at the club on the night of the dinner. If you intend to attend the dinner, please purchase the dinner ticket(s) through the event website so that we can get a preliminary count of the number of dinner attendees.

6. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS & CHANGES IN THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Notices to competitors will be posted on the event website. Changes to the Sailing Instructions shall be (i) posted to the event website or (ii) shall be communicated to Competitors at Competitors' meeting

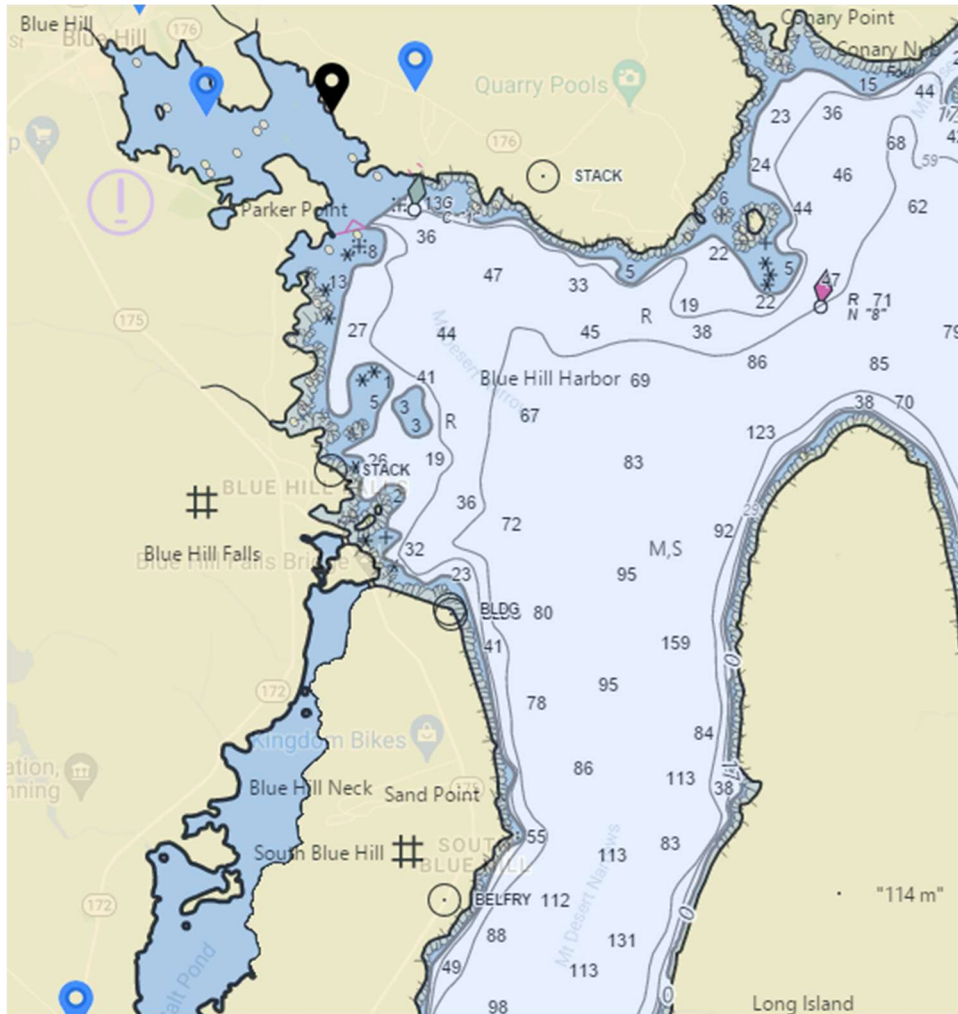

9. SCORING: A Low Point Scoring as per RRS Appendix A. 2 races are required to have a series. There will be one discard after 5 completed races.
